From the Pastor

The Second Mission of Seven

Mainly, we know the fate of St. Stephen on the second day of Christmas. The first martyr of the Church, one of the seven deacons, who was stoned to death in Jerusalem.

Sometimes we remember the scene when the second deacon, Philip, held a debate, which ended with a baptism, about the prophet Isaiah with an official of the Ethiopian queen Kandaki. But we are much less aware of the context of the activity of this second deacon. "A great persecution broke out in the Church of Jerusalem at that time. Everyone except the apostles scattered around Judea and Samaria. And Saul was destroying the church," wrote the author of the Acts of the Apostles, ending the story with Stephen's martyrdom.

Philip became the evangelizer of Samaria. The city of Samaria, which is the same as the name of the land in central Palestine, is not Sebaste, because it was a city of pagans, not Samaritans. The religious center of the Samaritans was Neapolis, lying on the site of Old Testament Shechem. It was here that "the crowds listened to the words of Philip because they saw the signs he was making." Seemingly nothing unusual, but the cultural context makes you stop here. The Samaritans were treated by Jews as heretics. The Pentateuch was their entire Bible. They had their own temple and their own sacrifices. They answered the Jewish reluctance with the same actions.

Suffice it to recall the beginning of Jesus' conversation with the Samaritan woman from John's Gospel: "How, being a Jew, are you asking me, a Samaritan woman, that I would give you a drink?" And yet the mission of deacon Philip had amazing results: "The apostles in Jerusalem learned that Samaria had accepted the word of God." The sign of this acceptance was baptism, but without the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. This was received by the baptized with the putting of the hands of the apostles. This also happened in Samaria, when Peter and John came here. This passage is sometimes referred to as one of the biblical arguments for the existence of the sacraments of baptism and confirmation. The work of the Holy Spirit is a whole, but from the perspective of the Church, immersed in temporality, not all aspects of its work are manifested at the same time.

Słowo Proboszcza

Misja drugiego z siedmiu

Głównie za sprawą drugiego dnia Bożego Narodzenia tak dobrze znamy los św. Szczepana. Pierwszy męczennik Kościoła, jeden z siedmiu diakonów, ukamienowany został w Jerozolimie.

Czasem wraca nam w pamięci scena, kiedy drugi z diakonów, Filip, toczył – zakończoną chrztem – debatę o proroku Izajaszu z urzędnikiem królowej etiopskiej Kandaki. Ale o wiele rzadziej uświadamiamy sobie kontekst tej działalności drugiego z diakonów. „Wybuchło wówczas wielkie prześladowanie w Kościele jerozolimskim. Wszyscy, z wyjątkiem apostołów, rozproszyli się po okolicach Judei i Samarii. A Szaweł niszczył Kościół” – napisał autor Dziejów Apostolskich, kończąc opowiadanie o męczeństwie Szczepana.

Filip stał się ewangelizatorem Samarii. Miasto Samaria, tożsame z nazwą krainy w środkowej Palestynie, to nie Sebaste, bo to było miastem pogan, a nie Samarytan. Ośrodkiem religijnym Samarytan było Neapolis, leżące w miejscu starotestamentalnego Sychem. To tutaj „tłumy słuchały słów Filipa, ponieważ widziały znaki, które czynił”. Z pozoru nic niezwykłego, ale kontekst kulturowy każe się tutaj zatrzymać. Samarytanie byli traktowani przez Żydów jako heretycy. Pięcioksiąg był ich całą Biblią. Mieli swą świątynię i własne ofiary. Za niechęć Żydów odpowiadali tym samym.

Wystarczy przypomnieć początek rozmowy Jezusa z Samarytanką z Janowej Ewangelii: „Jakżeż Ty będąc Żydem prosisz mnie, Samarytankę, bym ci dała się napić?”. A przecież misja diakona Filipa przyniosła zdumiewające owoce: „Apostołowie w Jerozolimie dowiedzieli się, że Samaria przyjęła słowo Boże”. Znakiem owego przyjęcia był chrzest, ale bez wylania Ducha Świętego. Tego otrzymywali ochrzczeni przez włożenie rąk apostołów. Tak stało się też w Samarii, gdy przybyli tu Piotr i Jan.

Ten fragment bywa przywoływany jako jeden z biblijnych argumentów za istnieniem sakramentów chrztu i bierzmowania. Dzieło Ducha Świętego stanowi całość, ale z perspektywy Kościoła, zanurzonego w doczesności, nie wszystkie aspekty Jego działania objawiają się jednocześnie.

SUNDAY READINGS

Reading 1 - Acts of the Apostles: 8:5-8, 14-17

Philip went down to the city of Samaria and proclaimed the Christ to them. With one accord, the crowds paid attention to what was said by Philip when they heard it and saw the signs he was doing. For unclean spirits, crying out in a loud voice, came out of many possessed people, and many paralyzed or crippled people were cured. There was great joy in that city.

Now when the apostles in Jerusalem heard that Samaria had accepted the word of God, they sent them Peter and John, who went down and prayed for them, that they might receive the Holy Spirit, for it had not yet fallen upon any of them; they had only been baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.

Then they laid hands on them and they received the Holy Spirit.

Reading 2 - 1 Peter 3:15-18

Beloved:
Sanctify Christ as Lord in your hearts. Always be ready to give an explanation to anyone who asks you for a reason for your hope, but do it with gentleness and reverence, keeping your conscience clear, so that, when you are maligned, those who defame your good conduct in Christ may themselves be put to shame. For it is better to suffer for doing good, if that be the will of God, than for doing evil.

For Christ also suffered for sins once, the righteous for the sake of the unrighteous, that he might lead you to God. Put to death in the flesh, he was brought to life in the Spirit.

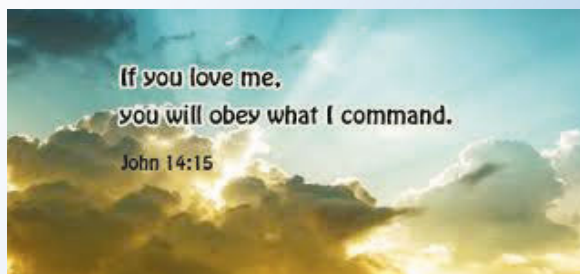

Gospel Meditation

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

My dad was adopted as a baby. It's a big part of my family's story. His birth mother placed him in a Catholic orphanage not long after birth. A young couple longing for a baby strolled among the bassinets. My father, then only a few months old, looked at the husband and smiled. The man said, "That's my son." They took him home and the family grew. This moment of adoption was a wonderful truth they celebrated even when my dad was a young boy. They told him, "You're even more special than the other children, because we chose you to be our son." My dad's eyes well up with tears of gratitude whenever he tells the story, even eighty-three years later.

What is your story? Do we think or act like unwanted orphans? Who do we believe ourselves to be? As we continue to ponder Jesus' resurrection, we hear him say to us this Sunday, "I will not leave you orphans." God doesn't leave us alone like spiritual orphans. The power that raised Jesus from the dead is the Holy Spirit, who is also called the Spirit of Adoption. He chooses us to be His children, to share God's life forever. He gives us a future filled with hope. We are not orphans anymore! This Easter, that's the story we should share with others. It's the true story we are living right now.

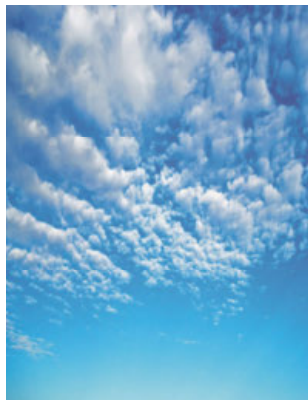

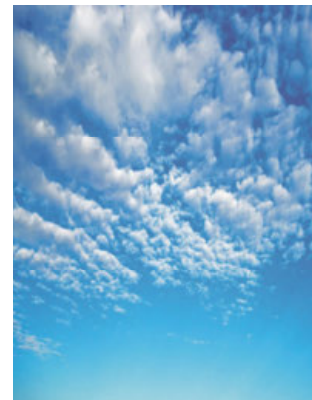
Are you searching for ways to serve the Lord while you attend Mass? If you have been thinking of becoming a St. Fabian Usher, let us help you find your way.
