From the Pastor

Dear Friends in Christ,

As we continue with the Archdiocese process of ***Renew My Church*** and move towards the “Lifelong Faith Formation” process it is important to understand what Lifelong Formation is and how it relates to our Parish and Community. Lifelong formation is the process through which we come to follow Jesus more closely throughout the course of our lives. Grounded in the Gospel, instruction in the faith and accompaniment in this journey of spiritual growth, lifelong formation equips us to respond to the events of our lives in light of the Gospel. These experiences, guided by the Holy Spirit and in communion with God and one another through the Church, help us answer our baptismal call to live as missionary disciples through the seasons of our lives.

Lifelong formation leads to deeper engagement in the life of the Church and in one’s community, including social transformation in light of the Gospel. In this way, lifelong formation plays a pivotal role in answering the call of ***Renew My Church*** to make disciples, build community and inspire witness.

With all the changes emerging in Building the New Reality, our parish has been strongly engaged with Vicarate V in making the necessary changes. The nature of our job is rapidly evolving – from Directors and Coordinators of Religious Education or Catechetical Leaders to Directors and Coordinators of Lifelong Faith Formation with a focus on evangelization. How will we address the needs we have, along with the changing needs of our catechists and families, in this new context? What do we need now and what will we need in the future?

As part of our future plan changes are being made to our children’s program. Change can be difficult; however, it is important as we continue to grow and build the new reality. The New Children’s Formation Board is committed to nourishing catechesis and evangelization in compliance with the mission and vision of the Catholic Church.

Our primary objective is to support and guide catechetical leaders in providing faith formation programs that “form believers for an integral Christian life, and pursues the following tasks:”

- Leading to knowledge of the faith
- Initiating into the celebration of the mystery
- Forming for life in Christ
- Teaching to pray
- Introducing to community life

This is in accordance with the mission of Renew My Church.

I want to personally thank our past RE Coordinator, Cindy Schlessner, for serving our children these past several years. I am grateful and appreciate all she has done to support both myself and Saint Fabian Parish.

We as a Parish will continue with the Archdiocese process of ***Renew My Church*** and moving forward with “***Building a New Reality***” and the “***New Evangelization***” plan.

Słowo Proboszcza

Prawda i Kościół

Pismo Święte pozwala nam poznać głęboką prawdę, prawdę nie będącą tylko wspomnieniem przeszłości, która minęła i stała się historią. Prawda ta jest nadal rzeczywistością dzisiejszego Kościoła i Kościoła wszystkich czasów, bo jest nią Duch Święty. To On nas poucza, kieruje nami i „popycha” nas we właściwych kierunkach.

Towarzyszy nam od naszego początku aż do końca, od chrztu świętego po namaszczenie olejami świętymi. Jest obecny we wszystkich sakramentach świętych, które są znakiem niewidzialnej łaski, udzielanej nam przez Boga. To Duch Święty uzdalnia nas do modlitwy czy przygotowuje do dobrej spowiedzi. Nam pozostaje tylko być otwartymi na to, co czyni w nas i dookoła nas.

Wszelkie nasze przymioty, charyzmaty, uczucia i decyzje są Jego dziełem, bo to z Jego natchnienia rodzą się w naszych sercach. To On jest Dawcą Łask, światłością sumień, radością serc, ochłodą w pracy, utuleniem w płaczu, On leczy rany, nagina, co harde, rozpala, co zimne, co zbłąkane prowadzi do przystani zbawienia. Duch Święty jest Duchem posłanym przez Chrystusa, aby dokonał w nas dzieła uświęcenia, które On nam wysłużył na ziemi. Dziękujmy Panu Jezusowi za Jego dary. Dziękujmy za dar pokoju. To jeden z najcenniejszych darów, jaki może spocząć w ludzkim sercu. To dar, który promieniuje taką mocą, że ucisza nawet najbardziej roztrzęsionych.

„Różne są dary łaski, lecz ten sam Duch; różne też są rodzaje posługiwania, ale jeden Pan; różne są wreszcie działania, lecz ten sam Bóg, sprawca wszystkiego we wszystkich. Wszystkim zaś objawia się Duch dla [wspólnego] dobra.” (1 Kor 12,5-7). Wolna wola, dana nam przez Boga, czasami prowadzi do błędnych decyzji i osądów, do złych działań. Zdając sobie z tego sprawę, tym bardziej powinniśmy wierzyć i dziękować Bogu za dzisiejsze Święto i za to, że poprzez Ducha Świętego spływają na nas Jego Dary. Dziękujmy słowami Sekwencji „Daj Twoim wierzącym, w Tobie ufającym, siedmiorakie dary. Daj zasługę męstwa, daj wieniec zwycięstwa, daj szczęście bez miary.”

For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body,

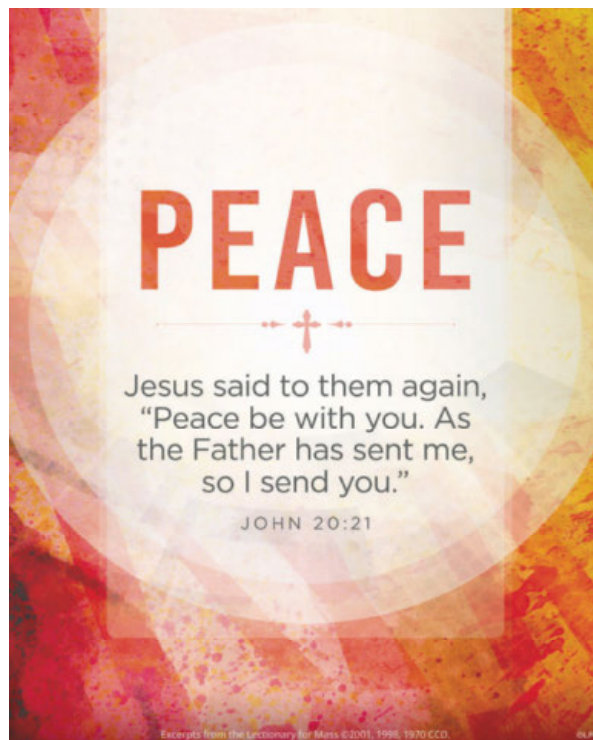
whether Jews or Greeks, slaves or free persons,

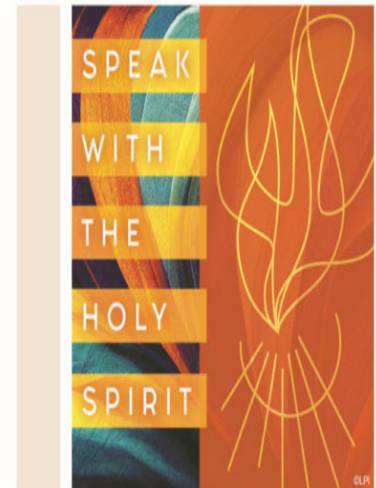

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Gospel Meditation

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

I hope you'll acknowledge with me a simple fact: it's not normal to have tongues of fire "part and come to rest" on people. It is actually pretty strange. Yet that is precisely what we celebrate in this feast of Pentecost. How can this mean something to us in our daily lives?

Jews had a tradition that heaven is a temple made of bricks of fire. So, through the apostles, the heavenly temple is coming to earth. But this fire looks like tongues, not bricks. That means that heavenly speech will be crucial to building a dwelling place for God on earth among men and women. So, it's no surprise when the apostles begin to speak in a miraculous way that is understood by all language groups. They are speaking of what God has done in and through Jesus: bringing heaven to earth and uniting all peoples to God and to each other.

How often our speech divides: gossip, slander, insults, and so on. How strange and rare it is when people speak in ways that truly unite instead of divide. Imagine how powerful it would be if you and I began to speak at home, at work, and in our community in a way that made people hear heavenly speech. Imagine if you spoke of the mighty deeds of God in a way that everyone could understand. That's precisely what the Holy Spirit descends upon us to do. Ask Him to come as a tongue of fire to you once again, and He will. Then speak!
