From the Pastor

Understanding the Mystery of the Trinity

Sometimes we have such a day that everything goes wrong, we get angry at everything and everyone. Instead of sitting back and thinking about your incompetence, we even revolt against ourselves. So if it is not easy for us to comprehend the surrounding reality and we blame our failures on others, if it is often difficult for us to understand ourselves, then we should be much more aware of our imperfections in relation to the mysteries of God.

The truth about the Holy Trinity is one of the most difficult truths of faith. To comprehend it, it is not enough to learn Bible knowledge and the teaching of the Church that flows from it. Here you need something more: humility of faith, which in a transcendent (extrasensory) way allows you to touch the realities of God's life as a unity of Three Persons. God is not someone far away. God is close to people and wants to seep his whole being. For love he called people to life, for love he sent his Son into the world to redeem people through the sacrifice of his cross, and for the sake of love, he sent the Holy Spirit, so that he would lead us to the work of sanctification. Revealing the mystery of the Holy Trinity, Christ also reveals the mystery of people. Only that it is difficult for us to understand: God sent his Son- that is, Himself, onto Earth, giving Him- that is, Himself, the help of the Holy Spirit, which is Himself- to Himself?

We must understand one thing - Faith in God in the Holy Trinity is the basis of the teaching of Christ's mission and His redemption. And this is the fundamental and underlying truth of our Catholic religion for all of us. The dogma of the Holy Trinity is above all a dogma of the living God, whose life consists of mutual possession, mutual devotion and perfect exchange. By sanctifying grace, we participate in the lives of three Divine Persons, getting to know the Father through the Son in the Love of the Holy Spirit.

For us, the faithful, those who have no theological education, sometimes it is difficult to understand the truth that in one Person we confess God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit, although we are aware that this is the most perfect society of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. God is perfect and there is no flaw in Him. In this unity of people, he is Love and selfless love. Similarly, a Christian family should be a community built on the foundation of love and unity. And finally, what is most important - the Holy Trinity teaches practical and personal love. That's it, we can embrace the rest with faith and understanding through Love for God.

Słowo Proboszcza

Zrozumieć Tajemnicę Trójcy

Czasami mamy taki dzień, że nic nam nie wychodzi, złościmy się na wszystko i wszystkich. Zamiast spokojnie usiąść i zastanowić się nad swoją nieudolnością, pomstujemy nawet na samych siebie. Jeśli więc niełatwo nam pojąć otaczającą rzeczywistość, a swoje niepowodzenia zrzucamy na innych, jeśli nieraz trudno nam zrozumieć samego siebie, to w o wiele większym stopniu powinniśmy zdać sobie sprawę z naszej niedoskonałości w odniesieniu do tajemnic Bożych.

Prawda o Trójcy Przenajświętszej to jedna z najtrudniejszych prawd wiary. By ją pojąć, nie wystarczy tylko przyswoić sobie wiedzę biblijną i wypływające z niej nauczanie Kościoła. Tu trzeba czegoś więcej: pokory wiary, która w sposób transcendentny (pozaśmysłowy) pozwala dotykać realiów życia Boga jako jedności Trzech Osób. Bóg nie jest Kimś znajdującym się gdzieś daleko. Bóg jest blisko człowieka i pragnie przenikać całe jego jestestwo. Z miłości powołał człowieka do życia, z miłości posłał na świat Swojego Syna, by przez ofiarę Jego krzyża dokonać odkupienia człowieka, wreszcie z miłości posłał Ducha Świętego, by Ten prowadził w nas dzieło uświęcenia. Chrystus, objawiając tajemnicę Trójcy Świętej, odkrywa jednocześnie tajemnicę człowieka. Tylko że nam to trudno zrozumieć: Bóg zesłał Syna – czyli siebie, na ziemię, dając mu – czyli sobie, do pomocy Ducha Świętego, czyli siebie – sobie?

Musimy zrozumieć jedno – Wiara w Boga w Trójcy Świętej Jedyne jest podstawą nauki o posłannictwie Chrystusa i dokonaniem przez Niego Odkupieniu. I to jest zasadnicza i podstawowa dla nas wszystkich prawda naszej religii katolickiej. Dogmat o Trójcy Przenajświętszej to przede wszystkim dogmat o Bogu żywym, którego życie polega na wzajemnym posiadaniu, na wzajemnym oddaniu i doskonałej wymianie. Przez łaskę uświęcającą bierzemy udział w życiu trzech Osób Boskich, poznając Ojca przez Syna w Miłości Ducha Świętego.

Nam, wiernym, tym którzy nie mają wykształcenia teologicznego, czasami trudno pojąć tę prawdę, że w jednej Osobie wyznajemy Boga Ojca, Syna i Ducha Świętego, mimo iż mamy świadomość, że to jest najdoskonalsza społeczność życia Ojca, Syna i Ducha Świętego. Bóg jest doskonały i nie ma w Nim żadnego braku. W owej jedności osób jest Miłością, i to Miłością bezinteresowną. Podobnie, wspólnotą zbudowaną na fundamencie miłości i jedności **powinna** być chrześcijańska rodzina. I wreszcie to, co najważniejsze – Trójca Święta uczy miłości praktycznej i osobowej. To tyle, resztę pozostaje nam objąć wiarą i zrozumieniem poprzez Miłość do Boga.

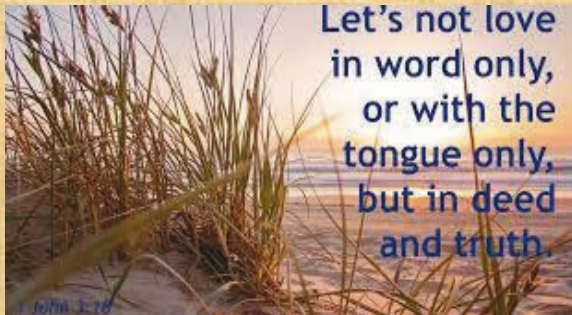

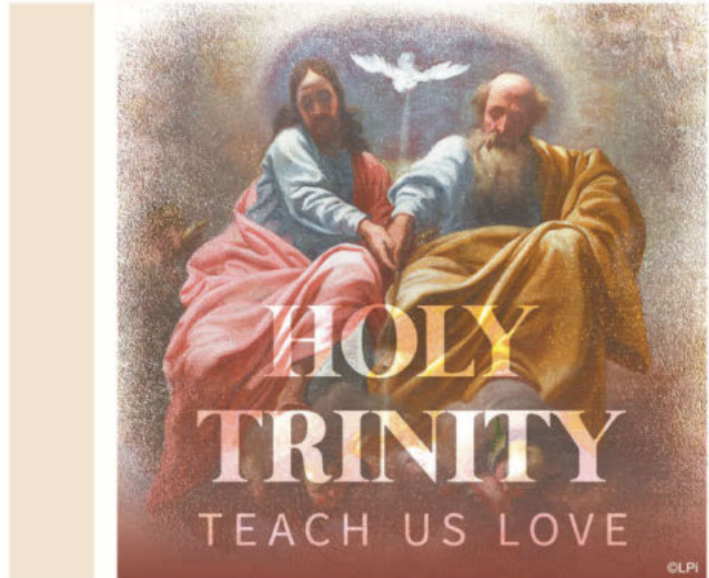

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Gospel Meditation

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

In my experience, one of the peculiarities of being a man is the somewhat unlikely ability to look into the mirror, no matter how out of shape he may be, and declare with full confidence: "Looking good, buddy!" Ask a man. He'll probably confirm it.

Therein lies a mystery. You might think I refer to man's ability to deceive himself or his propensity toward vainglory. But in this case, I refer to the mystery of a healthy and proper sense of self-love. We human beings (both men and women) have the utterly weird ability to look at ourselves as if we were another. Then we tend to love this "other." Then, somehow, that love becomes a bond between the two. We are three and yet one.

This Sunday is Trinity Sunday. We ponder anew that God in His unity is a play of multiplicity: Lover, Beloved, and shared Love. Or, as we also proclaim, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. If we allow it, this mystery heals our temptation toward self-hatred and destruction. We all know how awful it is to look into the mirror and not know the person we see, or, equally bad, to know and hate who we see. Jesus, the Son of God, draws us into the dynamics of authentic self-knowledge and self-love. Perhaps we could ask the Holy Trinity this Sunday to teach us to truly look at ourselves and to properly love who we see looking back.

We Bear the Name of the Lord

The name of the Lord is a curiously powerful thing. Say it deliberately, even in a group of people who are not particularly religious, and you'll know what I mean. There is a shift in the mood, a change in the atmosphere. When we utter the name of the Lord, He turns His head.

Once, in confession, I admitted to the sin of using the Lord's name in vain. "When you do that, tell God that you love him," advised the priest, who was wise enough to know that I would repeat this sin at some point. "You've said His name, after all. You have His attention."

We hear the name of the Lord, and we think of what it represents — John 3:16, salvation history summed up in a neat little sentence, the why and the how and the who of it all laid out before us. The Lord, so slow to anger that He offers us a million chances. The Lord, so rich in kindness and fidelity that He literally gave Himself to us that we might be saved.

But the name of the Lord is more than that. It is not just a symbol, it is an invitation. I think of Moses clutching the commandments, beseeching the Lord: "Come with us. Forgive us. Receive us as your own." The Lord accompanies us down the mountain. We bear the name of the Lord into the world with us wherever we go.

I have to ask myself: do I do that name justice?

Why do we do that? Catholic Life Explained

Question:

We live in a country that upholds the separation of Church and state. What is the role of Catholics in society?

Answer:

The role of the Church in the world has taken different forms over time, but the theme is the same. Be disciples in it! As the lay faithful — that is, not vowed priest or religious — we are called to live and love in the circumstances of our daily lives. St. John Paul II wrote a document about the laity. In it he wrote, "In their situation in the world God manifests His plan and communicates to them their particular vocation of seeking the Kingdom of God by engaging in temporal affairs and by ordering them according to the plan of God" (On the Lay Members of Christ's Faithful, 15).

God wants us in the hospitals, the board rooms, the law offices, the food pantries, and the little league games! We are to engage in the affairs of the world. But when we're there, we should live the plan of God. We need to respect those around us, engage in just business and legal practices, and love our children. We should care for the earth, use our money wisely, and get to know our neighbors. We must advocate for social policies that respect human dignity and human freedom. No matter our state in life, we are invited to build the kingdom of God!

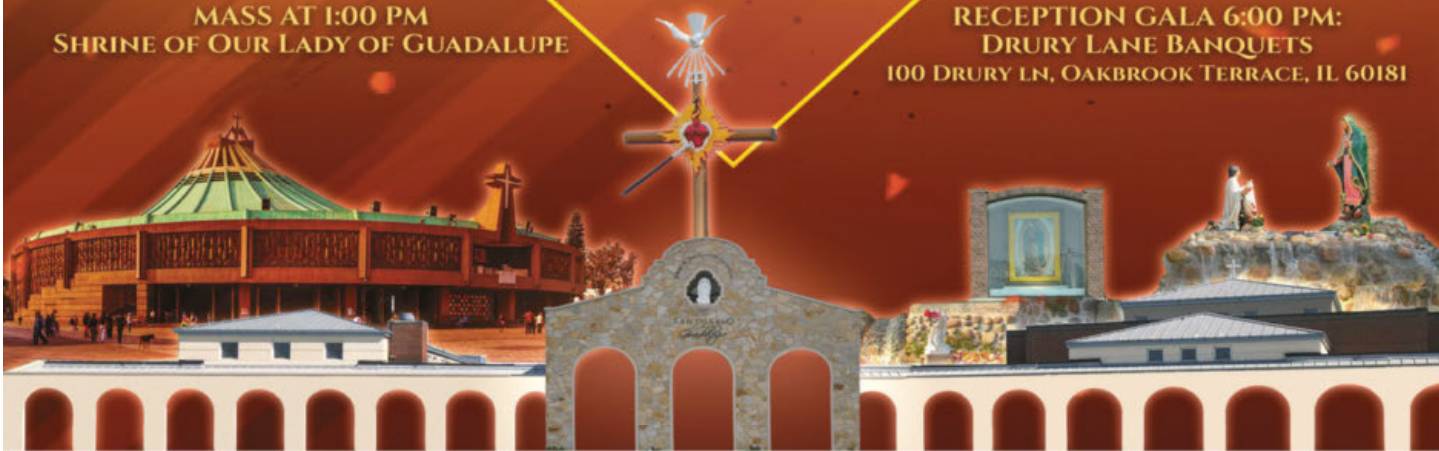

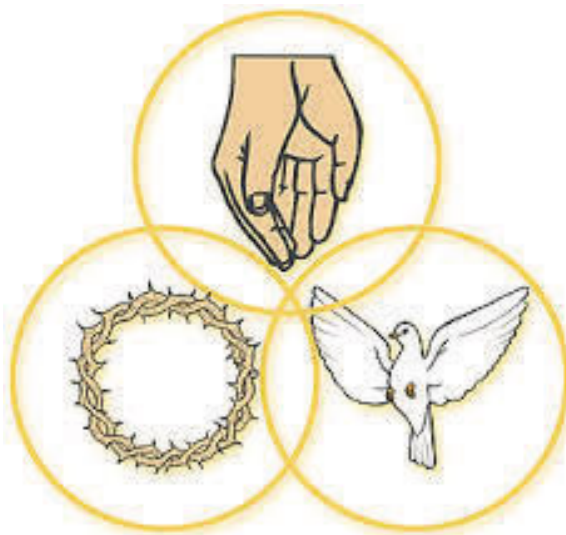
