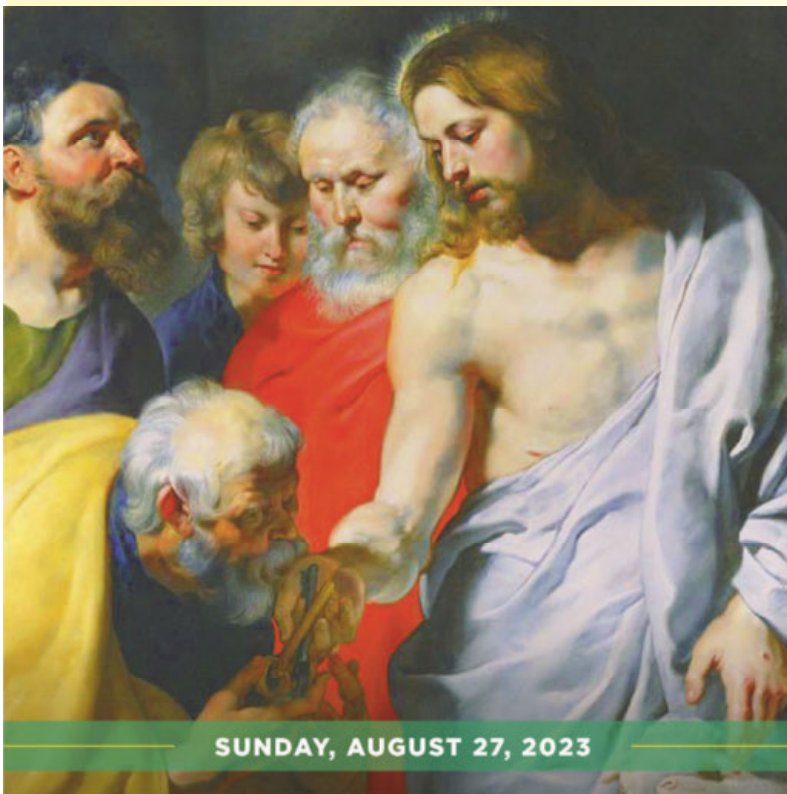

From the Pastor

PETER'S PRIMACY

Many of us, thanks to modern means of communication, can keep up with what is happening in the Church, both locally and universally. Pope Francis continues to enjoy unflagging interest in the world. Thousands of people gather in St. Peter's Basilica during Wednesday general audiences or the Sunday Angelus prayer. In addition to unexpected meetings, funny situations or gestures of papal kindness, tenderness and kindness, we have the opportunity to reach the words of Pope Francis, who, following the example of his patron - the Poverello of Assisi, draws from the purest source, You can visit the official websites of the Vatican media or listen to the Vatican Radio service, which is also broadcast by our Polish radio stations. his rich teaching.

To find the source and sense of Francis' papal ministry, we must turn to a passage from the Gospel. to be read for this Sunday. From the second half In the fourth century, Catholics interpret this text as unequivocally speaking of the primacy (priority) of the Bishop of Rome, the successor of St. Peter.

The Caesarea mentioned in the Gospel was close to the source of the Jordan. One of the rock caves from which this river flows was dedicated to a Greek god and nymphs as early as the 3rd century BC. At the top, a temple was built in honor of Caesar Augustus. The son of Herod the Great, Philip, expanded this place and called it Caesarea Philippi. In the minds of the Jews who worshiped Yahweh God, idolatry aroused indignation, disgust and anger. The aforementioned grotto resembled a gate leading to the depths of hell. Satan's kingdom. People had hoped that the gates of hell would one day open and shake the rock. on which stands the blasphemous temple and will swallow it up in the depths of hell.

It was in this place, full of horror, that the dialogue between Jesus, the Son of the living God, and Simon the fisherman, son of Jona, took place. Jesus talks about another rock on which he will build another temple - the Church of God. No infernal powers will ever prevail against it, though they will continually strike this rock. Jesus - the builder of the Church, laid the foundation on which he builds a temple for God of living stones. This construction will only be completed when Jesus is reborn at the end of time.

The entire role, task and mission of Peter in the Church was defined by Jesus using three metaphors: the rock, the power of the keys, and binding and loosing. On this text is based the authority of each pope, who is the vicar of Jesus on earth and the successor of St. Peter. Every pope is the Peter of his time. He is the rock of the Church, he has the power of the keys, he can bind and loosen.

Pope Francis, the Peter of our times, concerned for the good of the world and every human being, encourages us today to look at Jesus - the Messiah, who is the son of the living God. And as on the day of election to the See of St. Peter, still counts on our prayer that he may imitate Jesus Christ - the Good Shepherd and Head of the entire Church

Słowo Proboszcza

Prymat Piotra

Wielu z nas, dzięki współczesnym środkom komunikacji, może być na bieżąco z tym, co dzieje się w Kościele. Zarówno w wymiarze lokalnym, jak i powszechnym. Niesłabnącym zainteresowaniem świata cieszy się wciąż papież Franciszek. Tysiące ludzi gromadzi się na Placu św. Piotra w czasie środowych audiencji generalnych czy niedzielnej modlitwy „Anioł Pański”. Oprócz niespodziewanych spotkań, śmiesznych sytuacji czy gestów papieskiej dobroci, czułości i życzliwości, mamy możliwość docierać do słów papieża Franciszka, który na wzór swojego patrona – Biedaczyny z Asyżu czerpie z najczystszych źródeł, jakim jest Ewangelia. Można zajrzeć na oficjalne strony internetowe mediów watykańskich czy słuchać serwisu Radia Watykańskiego, który transmitują również nasze polskie rozgłośnie radiowe. Warto przy tej okazji wspomnieć, że 35 mln internautów obserwuje wpisy papieża Franciszka na Twitterze, wczytując się w krótkie myśli, perełki jego bogatego nauczania.

Aby znaleźć źródło i sens papieskiego posługiwania Franciszka musimy sięgnąć do fragmentu Ewangelii, przeznaczonego do odczytania na dzisiejszą niedzielę. Od II poł. IV wieku katolicy interpretują ten tekst jako jednoznacznie mówiący o prymacie (pierwszeństwie) biskupa Rzymu, następcy św. Piotra.

Cezarea, o której wspomina Ewangelia, leżała blisko źródeł Jordanu. Jedna z grot skalnych, z których wypływa ta rzeka, została już w III w przed Chrystusem poświęcona greckiemu bożkowi i nimfom. Na szczycie została wybudowana świątynia ku czci Cezara Augusta. Natomiast syn Heroda Wielkiego, Filip, rozbudował tę miejscowość i nazwał Cezareą Filipową. W umysłach Żydów, którzy czcili Boga Jahwe, bałwochwalstwo budziło oburzenie, odrzę i gniew. Wspomniana grot przypominała bramę wiodącą do czeluści piekielnych, królestwa szatana. Ludzie żywili nadzieję, że te bramy piekielne otworzą się pewnego dnia i wstrząsną skałą, na której stoi bluźniercza świątynia, i pochłoną ją w otchłanie piekielne.

Na tym właśnie miejscu, pełnym grozy, miał miejsce dialog Jezusa, Syna Boga żywego, z rybakiem Szymonem, synem Jony. Jezus mówi o innej skale, na której zbuduje inną świątynię – Kościół Boży. Żadne moce piekielne nigdy go nie przemogą, chociaż będą nieustannie w tę skałę uderzały. Jezus – budowniczy Kościoła, położył fundament, na którym buduje świątynię dla Boga z żywych kamieni. Budowa ta zostanie zakończona dopiero wtedy, gdy Jezus powtórnie przyjdzie na świat przy końcu czasów.

Całą rolę, zadanie i posłannictwo Piotra w Kościele Jezus określił za pomocą trzech metafor: skała, władza kluczy oraz związywanie i rozwiązywanie. Na tym tekście opiera się władza każdorazowego papieża, który jest namiestnikiem Jezusa na ziemi i następcą św. Piotra. Każdy papież jest Piotrem swoich czasów. Jest on skałą dla Kościoła, ma w nim władzę kluczy, może związywać i rozwiązywać.

Papież Franciszek, Piotr naszych czasów, zatroskany o dobro świata i każdego człowieka, zachęca nas dzisiaj do wpatrywania się w Jezusa – Mesjasza, który jest synem Boga żywego. I jak w dniu wyboru na Stolicę św. Piotra, nadal liczy na naszą modlitwę, by mógł naśladować Jezusa Chrystusa – Dobrego Pasterza i Głowę całego Kościoła.

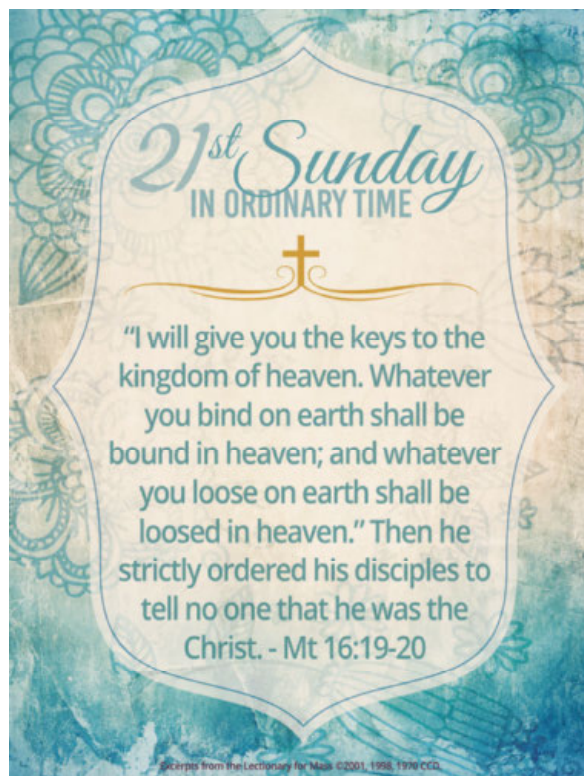

to tell no one that he was the Christ.



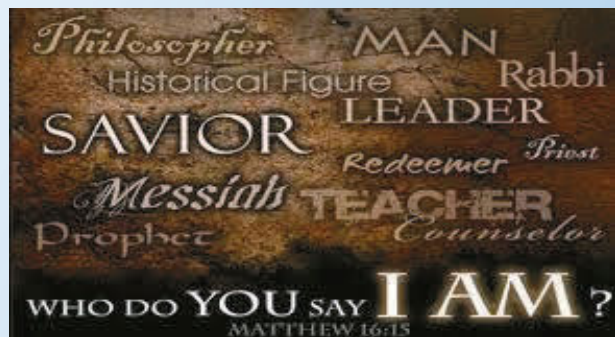

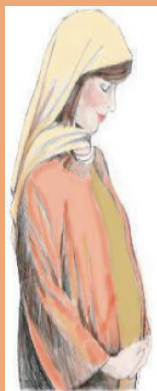

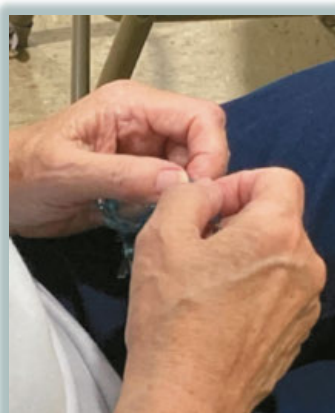
