From the Pastor

With Whom and for Whom

To understand today's reading, we first need to understand ourselves, stand in front of a mirror and look closely. What will we see? A face known to us for years, sometimes young, charming, sometimes furrowed with wrinkles. But that's not enough - we need to look deeper, into the soul.

What is in us is not written on the face, but it is rooted in the psyche, it is deep in the soul, it is in the recesses of the mind. Generally calm, we can often scold someone, curse someone or lead to depression. I am not exaggerating, because it is known that our self is usually dual, it has both good and bad sides. It depends on us how we behave in a given moment, in a given situation, in contact with a given person.

Sirach's wisdom tells us what a person is capable of, but it also tells us what to do. The first words are so obvious that they are beyond dispute: "Anger and wrath, these also are abominations, and the sinful man will possess them." (Sirach 27:30). The next are lessons: "Remember the end of your life, and cease from enmity, remember destruction and death, and be true to the commandments. Remember the commandments, and do not be angry with your neighbor; remember the covenant of the Most High, and overlook ignorance." (Sirach 28:6-7). How important and threatening these words are, which one cannot be indifferent to.

They are followed by the Letter of Saint Paul to the Romans, explaining why it is so important what we do, what we say, and how we act. We are Christians, we belong to the Church of Christ, and because we are part of the Church, we create it and constitute it: "If we live, we live to the Lord, and if we die, we die to the Lord; so then, whether we live or whether we die, we are the Lord's." (Romans 14:8).

The Gospel gives us an example of a bad understanding of mercy and love of one's neighbor. Immediately in the first words we have a full interpretation of love and mercy: to Peter's question, "Lord, how often shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? As many as seven times?" Jesus replied, "I do not say to you seven times, but seventy times seven." (Matthew 18:21-22). Can we make this effort to forgive them despite their repeated pain and impertinence, despite the pain inflicted on us by our neighbors? Is it worth it? The Gospel also gives us the answer: "So also my heavenly Father will do to every one of you, if you do not forgive your brother from your heart." (Matthew 18:35).

Binding all today's readings, reading the Gospel, let us consider how it is fitting for us to behave towards those who despise us, who hurt us, who ignore us? Let us forgive them and pray for them, because it is possible that they are doing it out of fear, in self-defense or aggression and are masking their request for help.

Słowo Proboszcza

Z kim i dla kogo

Aby zrozumieć dzisiejsze czytania, wpierw powinniśmy zrozumieć siebie, stanąć przed lustrem i dokładnie się sobie przyjrzeć. Co zobaczymy? Twarz znaną nam od lat, czasami młodą, powabną, czasami pooraną bruzdami zmarszczek. Ale to jeszcze mało – musimy sięgnąć wzrokiem głębiej, w duszę.

To, co w nas tkwi, nie jest wypisane na twarzy, lecz jest zakorzenione w psychice, siedzi głęboko w duszy, tkwi w zakamarkach umysłu. Na ogół spokojni, potrafimy niejednokrotnie kogoś zbesztać, zwymyślać czy doprowadzić do stanów depresyjnych. Nie przesadzam, bowiem wiadomo, że nasze ja jest zazwyczaj dwoiste, ma zarówno dobrą, jak i złą stronę. To od nas zależy, jak się zachowamy w danej chwili, w danej sytuacji, w kontakcie z daną osobą.

Mądrość Syracha mówi nam, do czego człowiek jest zdolny, ale równocześnie podpowiada, jak mamy postępować. Pierwsze słowa są tak oczywiste, iż pozostają poza dyskusją: „Złość i gniew są obrzydliwościami, których pełen jest grzesznik.” (Syr 27,30). Kolejne są pouczeniem: „Pamiętaj na ostatnie rzeczy i przestań nienawidzić; - na rozkład ciała, na śmierć, i trzymaj się przykazań! Pamiętaj na przykazania i nie miej w nienawiści bliźniego, - na przymierze Najwyższego, i daruj obrazę!” (Syr 28,6-7). Jakże to ważne i groźne słowa, wobec których przejść obojętnie nie można.

W ślad za nimi idzie List świętego Pawła do Rzymian, tłumaczący nam, dlaczego tak istotne jest to, co robimy, co mówimy, jak postępujemy. Jesteśmy chrześcijanami, należymy do Kościoła Chrystusowego, ponieważ zaś jesteśmy częścią Kościoła, to my go tworzymy i stanowimy: „jeżeli bowiem żyjemy, żyjemy dla Pana; jeżeli zaś umieramy, umieramy dla Pana. I w życiu więc i w śmierci należymy do Pana.” (Rz 14,8).

Ewangelia daje nam przykład złego zrozumienia miłosierdzia i miłości bliźniego. Zaraz w pierwszych słowach mamy pełną wykładnię miłości i miłosierdzia: na pytanie Piotra „«Panie, ile razy mam przebaczyć, jeśli mój brat wykroczy przeciwko mnie? Czy aż siedem razy?»» Jezus mu odrzekł: «Nie mówię ci, że aż siedem razy, lecz aż siedemdziesiąt siedem razy.» (Mt 18,21-22). Czy potrafimy zdobyć się na ten wysiłek, by mimo wielokrotnych przykrości, impertynencji, mimo bólu zadanego nam przez bliźnich, wybaczyć im? Czy warto? Na to również Ewangelia nam odpowiada: „Podobnie uczyni wam Ojciec mój niebieski, jeżeli każdy z was nie przebaczy z serca swemu bratu.» (Mt 18,35).

Wiążąc wszystkie dzisiejsze czytania, wczytując się w Ewangelię, zastanówmy się, jak nam przystoi się zachować wobec tych, którzy nami gardzą, którzy nas kaleczą, którzy nami pomiatają? Wybaczajmy im i módlmy się za nich, bo możliwe jest, iż czynią to ze strachu, w samoobronie bądź agresją maskując swoją prośbę o pomoc.

Wrath and anger are hateful things,
yet the sinner hugs them tight.
The vengeful will suffer the LORD's vengeance,
for he remembers their sins in detail.
Forgive your neighbor's injustice;
then when you pray, your own sins will be forgiven.
Could anyone nourish anger against another
and expect healing from the LORD?
Could anyone refuse mercy to another like himself,
can he seek pardon for his own sins?
If one who is but flesh cherishes wrath,
who will forgive his sins?
Remember your last days, set enmity aside;
remember death and decay, and cease from sin!
Think of the commandments, hate not your neighbor;
remember the Most High's covenant, and overlook faults.

that he might be Lord of both the dead and the living.

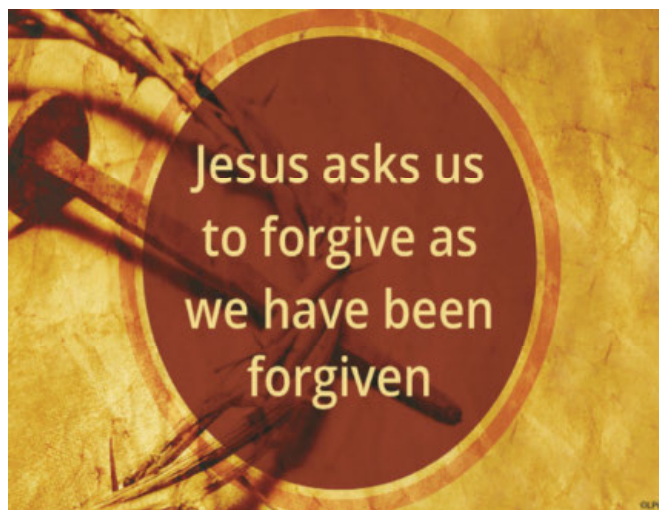

Peter approached Jesus and asked him,

That is why the kingdom of heaven may be likened to a king
who decided to settle accounts with his servants.
When he began the accounting,

a debtor was brought before him who owed him a huge amount.
Since he had no way of paying it back,
his master ordered him to be sold,
along with his wife, his children, and all his property,
in payment of the debt.
At that, the servant fell down, did him homage, and said,
'Be patient with me, and I will pay you back in full.'
Moved with compassion the master of that servant
let him go and forgave him the loan.
When that servant had left, he found one of his fellow
servants
who owed him a much smaller amount.
He seized him and started to choke him, demanding,
'Pay back what you owe.'
Falling to his knees, his fellow servant begged him,
'Be patient with me, and I will pay you back.'
But he refused.
Instead, he had the fellow servant put in prison
until he paid back the debt.
Now when his fellow servants saw what had happened,
they were deeply disturbed, and went to their master
and reported the whole affair.
His master summoned him and said to him, 'You wicked
servant!
I forgave you your entire debt because you begged me
to.
Should you not have had pity on your fellow servant,
as I had pity on you?'
Then in anger his master handed him over to the tortur-
ers
until he should pay back the whole debt.
So will my heavenly Father do to you,
unless each of you forgives your brother from your
heart."

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Gospel Meditation

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

When I was in second grade, my prized possession was a metal Star Wars-themed lunch box. After school one day, another student ripped it from my hands. I helplessly watched in horror as my classmate threw it to the ground and violently stomped it into an unrecognizable heap of junk. I came home covered in tears of shame and rage. After a few months, I never thought about it again ... until I was almost thirty years old and on a retreat to prepare for ordination to the priesthood.

That childhood memory — and the attendant outrage — came back afresh. My spiritual director helped me in the process of acknowledging that I was angry because that kid owed me my lunch box. Then she helped me, through the grace of Jesus, to forgive the debt. Almost immediately I felt a new peace. I was amazed that I hadn't forgotten what I had lost, even from years before. Aren't we human beings simply amazing at remembering what people owe us?

We see this week in Jesus' parable a servant who is forgiven much but then commands another servant: "Pay back what you owe!" He can't forget or let go of how he was wronged. He remembers — and he becomes a monster because of it. If only he had remembered not only the debts owed to him, but also his greater debt owed to — and forgiven by — his master. It's natural for us to remember what others owe us. But when we contextualize those offenses in Jesus' mercy toward us and them, we're free to be merciful like the Master and less like a monster who never forgets.

Thank you for everything you have done selflessly for our parish and school.

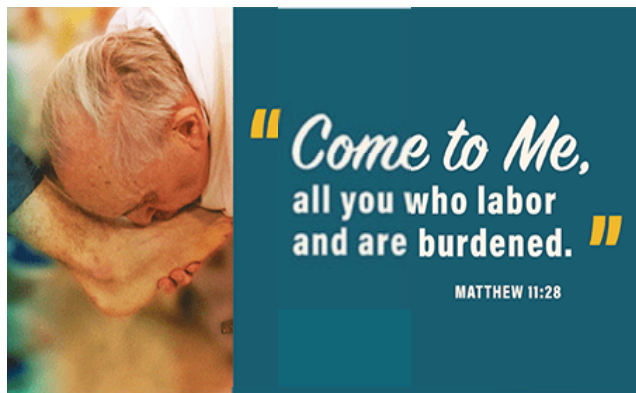

Answer:

The mission of the church reflects the mission of Jesus to teach, preach, heal, and forgive. Through these acts, Jesus shares the good news of salvation and invites all people to share in the life and love of God. The church continues this mission in all its ministries, but especially, and perhaps most importantly, through catechesis.

Catechetical Sunday is celebrated on the third Sunday of September. The task of handing on the Gospel is entrusted to the whole community, who by word and example, form young and new members in the way of the Gospel. Parish programs assist parents in teaching the basics of faith through liturgical experience, instruction, and faith formation. This ministry is essential for the parish to grow, for individuals to develop as believers, and for the ongoing spiritual formation of the whole community. It reminds the church that preaching the Gospel and growing in faith are essential to our sacramental practice and our liturgical prayer.
