Different Kinds of Silence

Whenever I meditated on this parable, my attention lingered on this speechless participant. He was silent, but he became the loudest figure at the feast. Everyone was talking, while he not only did not have the right robe on, but also shut himself up completely against the king.

The Greek language distinguished between at least three kinds of silence. There is a silence that is a sign of inner peace, meekness of spirit, modesty. Or being quiet to hear someone. The Greek calls this silence Hesychia. Being quiet is also a blessing. Being quiet in spirit comes from wanting to please God's gaze, not to please people. It is silence despite rejection, injustice, or the possibility of defense!

It stems from trust in God who will never leave us, although facts may indicate abandonment. The goal of all human work is finally to cease working, the Sabbath, to quietly rest in God's presence! Moses, who contemplated God, was mitissimus, most silent! The silence of the cross is imparted to the contemplative! By gazing at him silently, we begin to understand that only failure transforms our interior into love and a life that will not pass away because it will be invincible.

There is also silence, which becomes an expression of keeping a secret. Peter, John and James, when they saw Jesus transformed and heard that he was the Son of the Father of heaven, kept their silence. It was about keeping a secret. This silence the Greek liked to call sigao. But there is also such silence when someone's mouth is closed like putting a muzzle on a dog – fimoo! We would drastically call it a snub. This is what the Bible says about the silence of this man from the feast and the demon who tormented the possessed in the synagogue in Capernaum. Jesus told him forcefully, "Be silent!" In the same way, that He calmed a windy lake.

Słowo Proboszcza

Różne rodzaje milczenia

Zawsze kiedy medytowałem tę przypowieść, moja uwaga zatrzymywała się na tym oniemiałym uczestniku uczy. Milczał, ale stał się najgłośniejszą postacią na uczcie. Wszyscy rozmawiali, a on nie tylko nie miał właściwej szaty, ale jeszcze zamknął się na króla zupełnie.

Język grecki rozróżniał przynajmniej trzy rodzaje milczenia. Jest takie milczenie, które jest oznaką wewnętrznego spokoju, cichości ducha, skromności. Albo przynajmniej wyciszenia dla usłyszenia kogoś. Greka nazywa takie milczenie hesychia. Cichość jest też błogosławieństwem. Bycie cichym w duchu wypływa z pragnienia zdobycia upodobania Bożego spojrzenia, a nie przypodobania się ludziom. Jest to cisza mimo odrzucenia, mimo niesprawiedliwości, mimo możliwości obrony!

Wynika ona z zaufania do Boga, który nie opuści mnie nigdy, choć fakty mogą wskazywać na opuszczenie. Celem całej pracy ludzkiej jest ostatecznie zaprzestanie, czyli szabat cichego odpoczynku w obecności Boga! Mojżesz, który kontemplował Boga, był mitissimus, najcichszy! Cichość krzyża udziela się kontemplującemu! Wpatrując się w niego w milczeniu, zaczynamy rozumieć, że jedynie niepowodzenie przeobraża nasze wnętrza ku miłości i życiu, które nie miną, bo będą niepokonane.

Bywa też milczenie, które staje się wyrazem zachowywania tajemnicy. Piotr, Jan i Jakub, gdy zobaczyli Jezusa przemienionego i usłyszeli, iż jest Synem Ojca niebios, zachowywali milczenie. To było zachowywanie tajemnicy. Takie milczenie greka chętnie nazywała sigao. Ale jest również takie milczenie, kiedy komuś zamyka się usta na podobieństwo nałożenia psu kagańca – fimoo! Drastycznie nazwalibyśmy to stuleniem pyska. Tak właśnie Biblia mówi o zamknięciu tego gościa z uczy i demona, który targał opętanym w synagodze w Kafarnaum. Jezus powiedział do niego z mocą: „Milcz!”. W ten sam sposób ucisza wzburzone jezioro i wiatr.

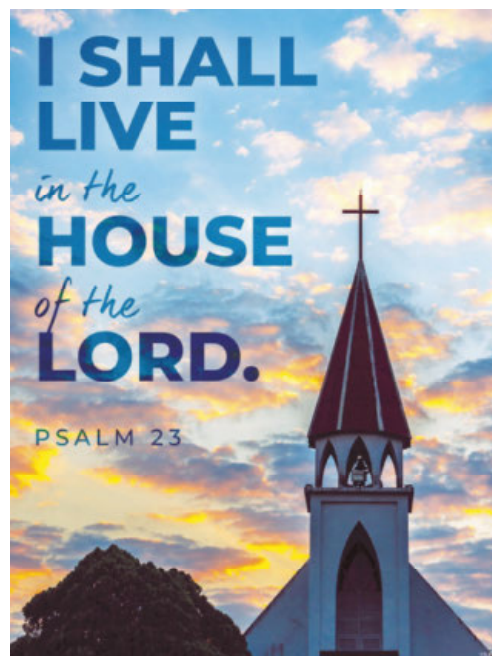

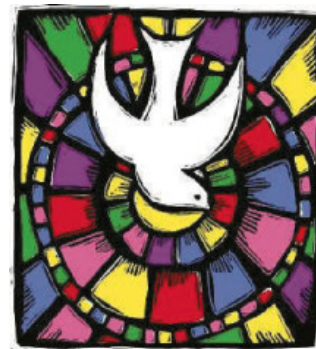

As Pastor (Administrator) of ST. FABIAN CHURCH, ID# 71250 (insert name of Parish/School/Shrine and Parish ID#) one of my primary functions is to be a good steward of the resources that have been entrusted with me to serve the people. 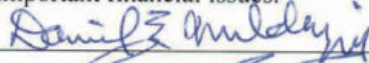

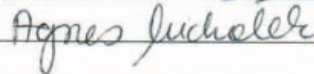

Dear Parishioners of St. Fabian Catholic Church,

The financial standing of our parish is on a solid foundation. Over the summer the school, including all classrooms, was painted and the flooring in Rooms 9 and 10 (O'Meara Hall) was replaced with floors that are easier to clean and maintain. The parish was able to negotiate contracts with lower pricing for essential services such as telephone, Internet, printing, and postage that resulted in significant cost savings. Streamlined purchasing procedures for office supplies and other important items were instituted and will continue to result in lower expenses. We are looking forward to other repair and renewal projects in the coming year. On behalf of Fr. Greg, the parish staff, the Finance Committee, and the Parish Pastoral Council, we want to thank all our parishioners for their heartfelt donations that are the lifeblood of our community.

Sytuacja finansowa naszej parafii jest oparta na solidnych podstawach. Wprowadzono usprawnione procedury zakupów materiałów biurowych i innych ważnych artykułów, które w dalszym ciągu będą skutkować niższymi wydatkami. Z niecierpliwością czekamy na kolejne projekty napraw i renowacji w nadchodzącym roku. W imieniu księdza proboszcza Grzegorza, pracowników parafii, Komisji Finansowej i Parafialnej Rady Duszpasterskiej chcemy podziękować wszystkim naszym parafianom za ich serdeczne i hojne datki, które są siłą napędową naszej wspólnoty.

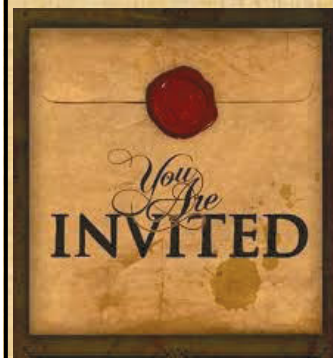

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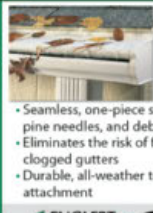
