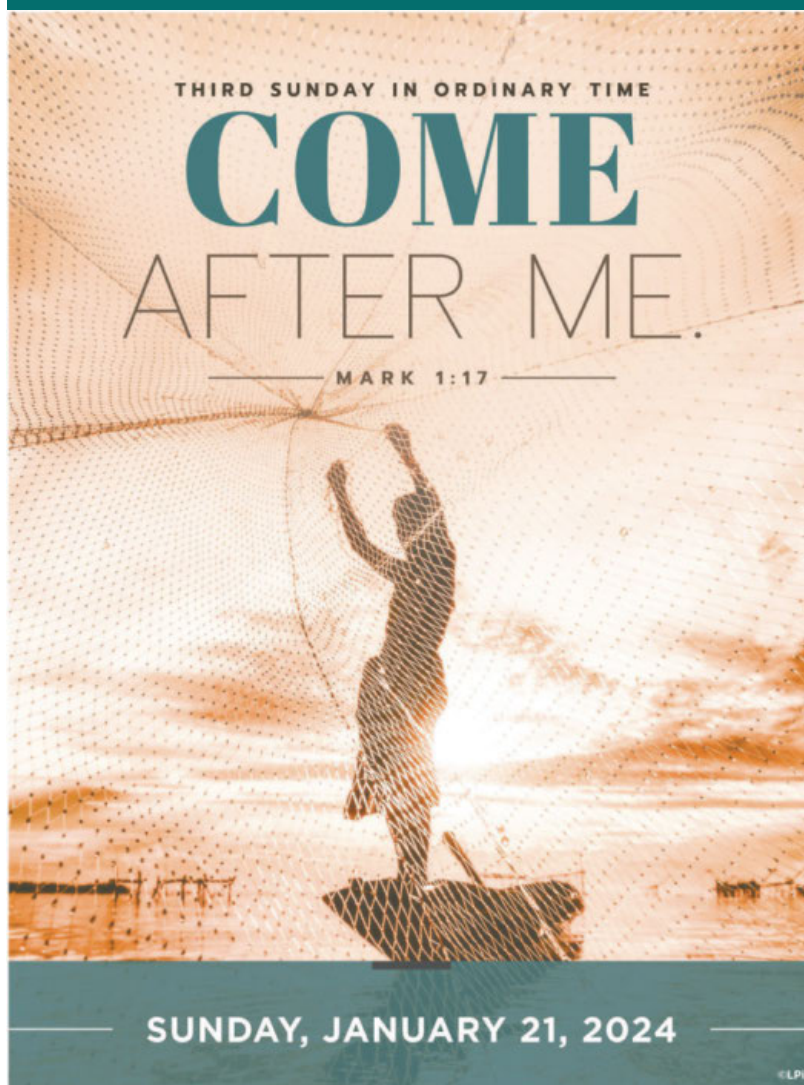

From the Pastor

Live in Prayer

The simple arrangement of objects allows a person to experience a soothing peace. And what about when we sort out our internal mess. We are looking for someone with whom we fit. This time Jesus did not call them, they followed him and walked for a long time, not knowing if he needed them, until he finally heard their footsteps imitating him. They wanted to live with Him. To live - it is to find your own place, that is, a space where a person feels neither anxiety nor alienation. There is only one space in which a person is free from anxiety, exile, alienation and rejection. It is a space of prayer that is dwelling in God. When prayer is your dwelling place and not just a passing visit, the Holy Spirit resides in you. The entire Bible is saturated with an irresistible need to see God. To know someone is, above all, to see. The God of the Old and New Testaments is the same invisible God, because Christ ultimately disappears after his resurrection, uniting himself with his invisible Father. He manifested himself in a human body to be seen despite being hidden in this world.

Are you already seeing where God lives? Have you already seen that He lives where He is overlooked or even ignored? Nothing ever and no one ever satisfied my spiritual longing. Everything I encountered in the course of fate calmed the surface of the heart or the epidermis of a restless mind for a moment. Can I satisfy my hunger for spirit with a sumptuous dinner or staring at a plasma screen, drinking alcohol or enjoying sex? Deeper than we are aware of it, there is a power of longing in us that opposes this constant clogging with appearances and substitutes. It is not enough for us to know that there is God. We long to catch up with Him, to make Him answer for His indwelling.

They went and saw where he was staying, and they stayed with him that day. They saw and stayed. Maybe seeing itself was reaching the goal, staying and dwelling? The simple arrangement of objects allows a person to experience a soothing peace. And what only when we clean up the internal mess of thoughts and feelings, memories and relationships, prayers and gazing into God's eyes! When Jesus is in his place in my soul and I dwell in prayer, everything else finds its place. Then in everything we discover the meaning and sense that God really gave these realities.

Słowo Proboszcza

Zamieszkać w modlitwie

Zwykłe uporządkowanie przedmiotów pozwala człowiekowi doznać kojącego pokoju. A coś dopiero, gdy porządkujemy wewnętrzny bałagan.

Szukamy kogoś, przy kim się odnajdujemy. Tym razem Jezus ich nie powoływał, to oni poszli za Nim i szli długo, nie wiedząc, czy ich potrzebuje, aż w końcu usłyszał ich naśladujące Go kroki. Zapragnęli z Nim zamieszkać. Zamieszkać – to znaleźć swoje miejsce, czyli taką przestrzeń, w której człowiek nie odczuwa ani niepokoju, ani wyobcowania. Jest tylko jedna jedyna przestrzeń, w której człowiek jest wolny od niepokoju, wygnania, wyobcowania, odrzucenia. To przestrzeń modlitwy, która jest zamieszkiwaniem w Bogu. Gdy modlitwa jest dla ciebie już mieszkaniem, a nie przelotnymi odwiedzinami, w tobie samym rezyduje Duch Święty. Cała Biblia jest nasycona nieodpartą potrzebą ujrzania Boga. Znać kogoś, to nade wszystko widzieć. Bóg Starego i Nowego Testamentu jest tym samym niewidzialnym Bogiem, bo Chrystus ostatecznie znika po zmartwychwstaniu, jednocząc się ze swym niewidzialnym Ojcem. Objawił się w ludzkim ciele, aby dać się zobaczyć mimo swego ukrycia w tym świecie.

Czy już dostrzegasz, gdzie mieszka Bóg? Czy już to zobaczyłeś, że mieszka On tam, gdzie jest się niedostrzegany, a nawet pomijany? Nic nigdy i nikt nigdy nie zaspokoił mojej tęsknoty duchowej. Wszystko, co napotykałem na trasie losu, uśmierzało na chwilę powierzchnię serca lub naskórek niespokojnego umysłu. Czy moje łaknienie ducha mogę zaspokoić sutym obiadem albo wpatrywaniem się w plazmowy ekran, upajając się alkoholem albo napawając seksem? Głębiej, niż zdajemy sobie z tego sprawę, istnieje w nas siła tęsknoty, która sprzeciwia się tym nieustannym zapychaniem się pozorami i namiastkami. Nie wystarcza nam wiedzieć, że jest Bóg. Tęsknimy za dośnięciem Go, by wymóc na Nim odpowiedź o Jego zamieszkiwanie.

Poszli i zobaczyli, gdzie mieszka i tego dnia pozostali u Niego. Zobaczyli i pozostali. Może samo widzenie było dotarciem do celu, pozostaniem i zamieszkiwaniem? Zwykłe uporządkowanie przedmiotów pozwala człowiekowi doznać kojącego pokoju. A coś dopiero, gdy porządkujemy wewnętrzny bałagan myśli i uczuć, wspomnień i relacji, modlitwy i zapatrzenia w oczy Boga! Gdy Jezus jest na swoim miejscu w mojej duszy i gdy ja zamieszkuję w modlitwie, wszystko inne odnajduje swoje miejsce. Wtedy we wszystkim odkrywamy sens i znaczenie, jakie naprawdę nadał m rzeczywistościom Bóg.

For the world in its present form is passing away.

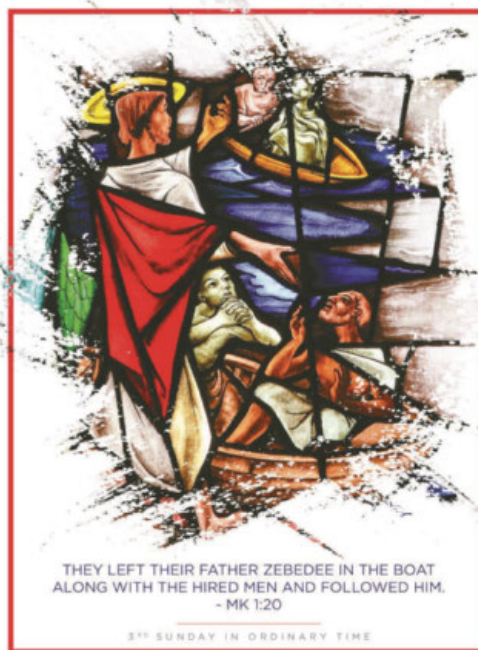

The current roof is a series of patches, and it has never been completely replaced. The roof is over 30 years old. Estimates to replace the roof average about \$600,000. To pay for the roof we ask all parishioners to join our pledge drive. The theme of our pledge drive is **“Gather the Faithful Under the Roof”**. We ask if possible, for every household to pledge \$1,000. Any and all donations are gratefully appreciated. Please do your best to support the pledge drive. Pledge cards will be available next weekend. Pledge amounts can be donated weekly, monthly or in one amount. You can also donate on the Saint Fabian Website under Give Central. The pledge drive will begin next weekend and end on the weekend of June 29th & 30th, 2024. \$600,000 is our goal and any and all pledge amounts are greatly appreciated. Zbierz wiernych pod dachem

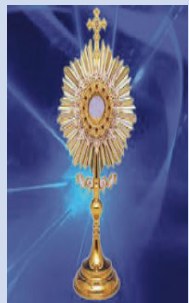
„Czcij Pana [ofiarą] z twego mienia i pierwocinami całego dochodu...”

Jako wierni członkowie parafii Świętego Fabiana jesteśmy błogosławieni przez Boga wspaniałym budynkiem parafialnym, jednak dach wymaga wymiany, jak wspomniano w biuletynie w ubiegłym tygodniu. boczny dach wielokrotnie był poprawiany, reperowany, łatany, jednak nigdy nie został całkowicie wymieniony. Dach ma ponad 30 lat. Szacunkowa wymiana dachu wynosi około \$600 000 . Aby opłacić wymianę dachu, prosimy wszystkich parafian o przyłączenie się do naszej zbiórki. 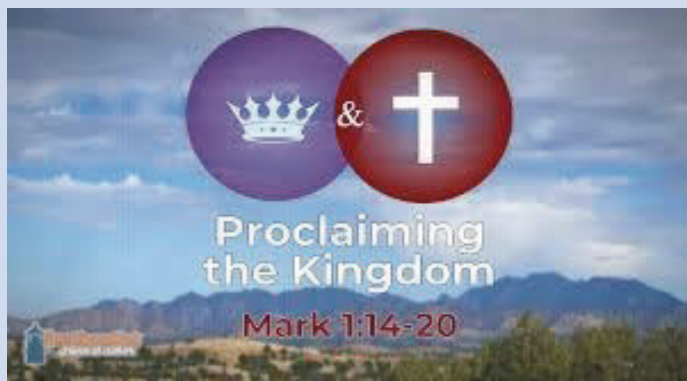

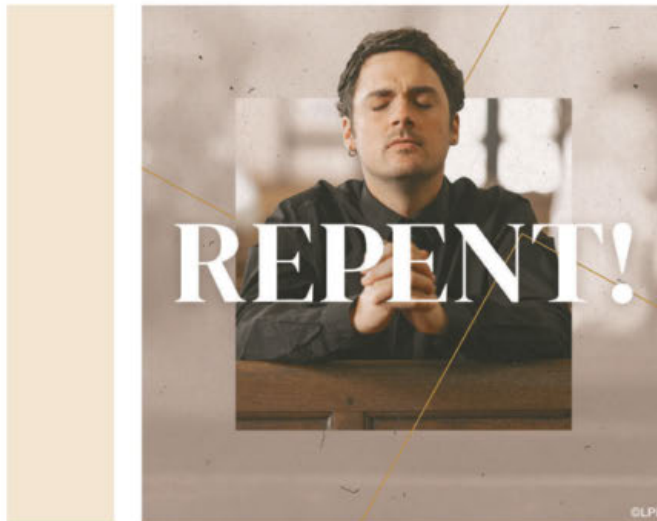

Gospel Meditation

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

We start telling lies around the age of three, the experts tell us. It's understandable. Lying is a god-like power. Whatever I want, I need only say it, and the world rearranges itself accordingly. It's amazing at first. But soon reality snaps back and I'm faced with a dilemma. If I remain committed to my lie I start to fracture into pieces. My words and reality drift apart, and I find myself lost in a lonely world of further falsehoods and fear of being found out.

How marvelous, then, that Jesus begins his ministry by proclaiming: **"Repent!"** We tend to think it means "stop doing bad things" but it doesn't. It literally means "go beyond the mind you have." Think in a new way. It's painful to admit, but some portion of my mind is addicted to lie-telling, usually to protect my ego or make life easier. To repent means to admit this tendency, to say, "I'm done lying," and to move beyond my split mind into a complete commitment to the truth. Perhaps that's why at Mass we together proclaim, "I have sinned in my *thoughts*, and in my *words*..." Repentance and truth-telling work together.

Those who know the twelve-step process of addiction recovery know this process well. The fourth step requires radical truth-telling: listing our moral defects. This isn't being scrupulous. Rather it is freedom from falsehood, and entrance into the real world. This week, I invite you to join me in this practice. Get your phone or piece of paper. Answer the question: what are your true moral defects? Write them down. Remember, the Lord knows them already and loves you. We have a sacrament where this truth-telling is celebrated: Confession. Perhaps it is finally time to go beyond our childish lies.

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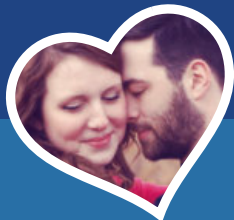
