From the Pastor

Who is for and who is Against?

In times that many of us recall as uninteresting and wrong, we were taught that what they tell and teach us at school and at work is only true, and that we must remember this in order not to have problems with the people who show "special concern" for our worldview. The so-called Manifestos and "sit-ins" in workplaces were designed to indoctrinate and put everyone in one line. Now we have "freedom of speech and action" and yet again we complain about the times.

However, there are cases where we should pay more attention to both the words and the people who speak them. What constitutes the basis of our life is our faith and the words of the Lord, not only spoken in the Holy Scriptures or in the Liturgy of the Word during holy masses, but also communicated to us by prophets, both ancient and modern, who, using Tradition and Scripture they want to evangelize us. But let us consider what the Lord says: "Anyone who does not heed the words that the prophet shall speak in my name, I myself will hold accountable. But any prophet who speaks in the name of other gods, or who presumes to speak in my name a word that I have not commanded the prophet to speak—that prophet shall die." (Deuteronomy 18:19-20). You will say: where do we find the prophets today? It is today, in our time, that we often encounter people who want to preach the word to us, but this word is not always the Word of God. We cannot be fooled. Let us listen to what God wants to tell us in the places reserved for it, because those who try to deceive us avoid places intended for the preaching of the Word.

In the first letter to the Corinthians, Saint Paul tries to show us how we can reach the Lord directly, which of course does not mean that each of us must go the same way.

Today's Gospel shows us Christ teaching and casting out unclean spirits. It makes us realize the necessity to constantly deepen our knowledge about faith, about Christ and about eternity. Our knowledge should not be limited to the knowledge of religions acquired in elementary school. We have to learn throughout our lives, because at every moment of our life, gaining new elements of knowledge, we expand our knowledge, our scope of view and understanding. Let us not leave our own knowledge at the level of God - an old man with a gray beard, but let us understand the boundless love of God the Father, who will give us everything we ask for, if we reciprocate this love, if we hope to meet in eternity, if we believe in it.

Słowo Proboszcza

Kto za, a kto przeciw?

Za czasów, które wielu z nas wspomina jako nieciekawe i niesłuszne, uczono nas, iż to, co nam w szkole i w pracy przekazują i czego nas uczą, jest jedynie prawdziwe, i że musimy o tym pamiętać, by nie mieć problemów z ludźmi okazującymi „specjalną troskę” o nasz światopogląd. Tzw. manifesty i „nasiadówki” w zakładach pracy miały za zadanie indoktrynację i ustawienie wszystkich w jednym szeregu. Teraz mamy „wolność słowa i czynu”, a mimo to znów narzekamy na czasy.

Jednak są przypadki, w których powinniśmy zwracać większą uwagę zarówno na słowa, jak i na ludzi, którzy je głoszą. Tym, co stanowi podstawę naszego życia, jest nasza wiara i Słowa Pana, nie tylko wypowiedane w Piśmie Świętym czy w Liturgii Słowa podczas mszy świętych, ale również przekazywane nam przez proroków, zarówno tych starożytnych, jak i współczesnych, którzy posiłkując się Tradycją i Pismem pragną nas ewangelizować. Lecz weźmy pod rozwagę to, co mówi Pan: „Jeśli ktoś nie będzie słuchać moich słów, które on wypowie w moim imieniu, Ja od niego zażądam zdania sprawy. Lecz jeśli który prorok odważy się mówić w moim imieniu to, czego mu nie rozkazałem, albo wystąpi w imieniu bogów obcych – taki prorok musi ponieść śmierć” (Pwt 18, 19-20). Powiecie: a gdzie to dzisiaj znajdziemy proroków? Właśnie dzisiaj, w naszych czasach, często napotykamy ludzi, którzy chcą nam głosić słowo, jednakże nie zawsze to słowo jest Słowem Bożym. Nie możemy dać się zwieść. Słuchajmy tego, co chce nam przekazać Bóg, w miejscach do tego przeznaczonych, gdyż ci, którzy nas próbują zwieść, unikają miejsc przeznaczonych do głoszenia Słowa.

W pierwszym Liście do Koryntian święty Paweł próbuje nam pokazać, w jaki sposób możemy dotrzeć bezpośrednio do Pana, co oczywiście nie oznacza, iż każdy z nas musi iść tą samą drogą.

Ewangelia dzisiejsza pokazuje nam Chrystusa nauczającego i wypędzającego duchy nieczyste. Uświadamia nam to konieczność nieustannego pogłębiania wiedzy o wierze, o Chrystusie, o wieczności. Nasza wiedza nie powinna ograniczać się do wiadomości z religii zdobytych w szkole podstawowej. Uczyc musimy się przez całe życie, bowiem w każdym momencie życia, zdobywając kolejne elementy wiedzy, poszerzamy swoją wiedzę, swój zakres widzenia i rozumienia. Nie pozostawiamy własnej wiedzy na poziomie Boga – staruszka z siwą brodą, lecz chcemy zrozumieć bezgraniczną miłość Boga Ojca, który da nam wszystko, o co poprosimy, jeśli odwzajemnimy tę miłość, jeśli będziemy mieć nadzieję spotkania w wieczności, jeśli będziemy w to wierzyć.

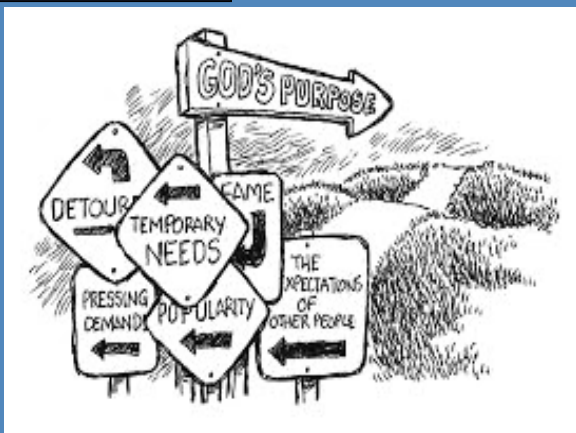

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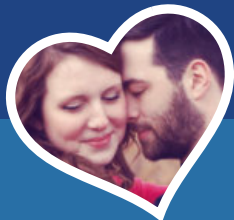
