# From the Pastor

## The Pendulum Over the Cutlet

All the chiefs of Judah, priests, and people multiplied iniquities, imitating all the abominations of the heathen nations. We hear thousands of times that something happened in the West a long time ago, so it's high time for others to follow the same footsteps. This is the argument for homosexual relationships, abortion, euthanasia, political and economic trends. Jerusalem was burned down because no one else's heart burned with love for God when reading the holy verses of the Torah.

History returns. Today people wear amulets instead of scapulars, instead of kneeling at the confessional, they lie on psychoanalysts' couches or go to fortunetellers. Children, instead of little medals with angels, carry Pokemon in their pockets. Young people read "The Da Vinci Code," which shreds their intelligence more effectively than a Chinese knife cuts a cabbage. Posters invite you to transcendental meditations, which for only 50 dollars promise to transfer you to another dimension. Why is this happening? Harald Baer states: "The occult explosion is a phenomenon of protest against fossilized Christianity." The fascination with the occult is a manifestation of the insufficiency of the mystical element in the Church, as well as a certain ignorance. Quackery, fortune-telling, clairvoyance, eastern meditations, and many other alternative spiritual wastelands pushes people into evolutionary regression. Of course, for a fuller picture, you still need alternative medicine, homeopathy, healing with magic, a bit of spiritism, hypnosis, bioenergotherapy, radiesthesia, and mysterious trances. Maybe a pendulum over the cutlet to see if it's spiritually positive, and a few more silver acupuncture pins at the tip of your upturned nose. What is the result of such searches? Unexplained depression, erratic behavior, uncontrolled desire, sexual deformity, unstoppable anger, obsessive thoughts and feelings, constant fear, anxiety, nervousness or neurotic behavior, suicidal thoughts, indifference to spiritual matters, blasphemous thoughts against God, aversion to the sacraments, repetitive failure. Not all spirituality comes from the Holy Spirit, there are also spirits darker than the night and they lead a person to something worse than mere ignorance. "Magic is the power of the defenseless," explains Hubert Kohle. Is it any wonder that we have twice as many exorcists than ten years ago? Is it any wonder that they are overloaded and besieged by frightened penitents?

Nicodemus came by at night and talked with Jesus in the darkness. He was in the dark. In fact, it was darkness that forced him to look for Jesus. What compels us to convert is enslavement to darkness, the visible action of the forces of darkness. Whoever fulfills the requirements of truth moves closer to the light. Many people only return to God when their ungodliness causes them such torment that life becomes unbearable for them. How do you get out of it? The first thing is to return to Jesus Christ, even in the darkness of the night!

# Słowo Proboszcza

## Wahadelko nad kotлетem

Wszyscy na- czelnicy Judy, kapłani i lud mnożyli nieprawości, naśladować wszelkie obrzydliwości narodów pogańskich. – Słyszymy tysiące razy, że na Zachodzie coś już dawno zaistniało, dlatego najwyższy czas, by i inni poszli tymi samymi śladami. Tak się argumentuje związki homoseksualne, aborcję, eutanazję, polityczne i ekonomiczne mody. Jerozolima spłonęła, ponieważ nikomu serce nie płonęło już miłością do Boga przy czytaniu świętych wierszy Tory.

Historia wraca. Dziś ludzie zamiast szkaplerza noszą amulety, zamiast klęczeć przy konfesjonale, leżą na kozetkach psychoanalityków lub chodzą do wróżki. Dzieci zamiast medalików z aniołami noszą w kieszeniach pokemony. Młodzież rozczytuje się w „Kodzie Leonarda da Vinci”, który szatkuje jej inteligencję skuteczniej niż nóż pekińską kapustę. Plakaty zapraszają na medytacje transcendentalne, które za jedyne 50 dolarów obiecują przeniesienie w inny wymiar. Dlaczego tak się dzieje? Harald Baer stwierdza: „Eksplozja okultyzmu jest zjawiskiem protestu przeciw skostniałemu chrześcijaństwu”. Fascynacje okultyzmem to przejaw niewystarczalności elementu mistycznego w Kościele, a także pewnej ignorancji. Znachorstwo, wróżbiarstwo, jasnowidztwo, medytacje wschodnie i wiele innych alternatywnych bezdroży duchowych wpycha człowieka w ewolucyjny regres. Oczywiście dla pełniejszego obrazu potrzeba jeszcze alternatywnej medycyny, homeopatii, uzdrowienia magią, odrobinę spirytyzmu, hipnozy, bioenergoterapii, radiestezji, tajemniczych transów. Może jeszcze wahadelko nad kotлетem sprawdzające, czy jest duchowo pozytywny, i jeszcze kilka akupunkturowych szpilek srebrnych w czubek zadartego nosa. Co jest efektem takich poszukiwań? Niewyjaśnione depresje, nieobliczalne zachowania, niekontrolowane pożądanie, seksualne deformacje, złość nie do powstrzymania, obsesyjne myśli i uczucia, nieustanny strach, niepokój, nerwowość lub neurotyczne zachowanie, myśli samobójcze, obojętność dla spraw duchowych, bluźniercze myśli przeciwko Bogu, wstręt do sakramentów, powtarzające się niepowodzenia. Nie każda duchowość jest od Ducha Świętego, istnieją również duchy ciemniejsze niż noc i wprowadzające człowieka w coś gorszego niż zwykła ciemnota. „Magia jest mocą bezbronnych” – wyjaśnia Hubert Kohle. Czy można się dziwić, że mamy dwa razy więcej egzorcystów niż dziesięć lat temu? Czy można się dziwić, że są przeciążeni i obłędni przez przerażonych penitentów?

Nikodem przyszedł w nocy i rozmawiał w ciemnościach z Jezusem. On był w ciemnościach. Właściwie to ciemności zmusiły go do poszukiwania Jezusa. To, co przymusza nas do nawrócenia, to zniewolenie ciemnością, widoczne działanie sił mroku. Kto spełnia wymagania prawdy, zbliża się do światła. Wielu ludzi powraca do Boga dopiero wtedy, gdy bezbożność doprowadza ich do takiej męki, że życie staje się dla nich nie do wytrzymania. Jak z tego wyjść? Pierwsza rzecz – to powrócić do Jezusa Chrystusa, choćby w ciemnościach nocy!

## SUNDAY READINGS

**Reading 1: 2 Chronicles 36:14-16,  
19-23**

In those days, all the princes of Judah, the priests, and the people added infidelity to infidelity, practicing all the abominations of the nations and polluting the LORD's temple which he had consecrated in Jerusalem.

Early and often did the LORD, the God of their fathers, send his messengers to them, for he had compassion on his people and his dwelling place.

But they mocked the messengers of God, despised his warnings, and scoffed at his prophets, until the anger of the LORD against his people was so inflamed

that there was no remedy.

Their enemies burnt the house of God,

tore down the walls of Jerusalem,

set all its palaces afire,

and destroyed all its precious objects.

Those who escaped the sword were carried captive to

Babylon,

where they became servants of the king of the Chaldeans and his sons

until the kingdom of the Persians came to power.

All this was to fulfill the word of the LORD spoken by Jeremiah:

"Until the land has retrieved its lost sabbaths, during all the time it lies waste it shall have rest while seventy years are fulfilled."

In the first year of Cyrus, king of Persia, in order to fulfill the word of the LORD spoken by Jeremiah,

the LORD inspired King Cyrus of Persia to issue this proclamation throughout his kingdom, both by word of mouth and in writing:

"Thus says Cyrus, king of Persia:

All the kingdoms of the earth

the LORD, the God of heaven, has given to me, and he has also charged me to build him a house in Jerusalem, which is in Judah.

Whoever, therefore, among you belongs to any part of his people,

let him go up, and may his God be with him!"

Brothers and sisters:

God, who is rich in mercy,

because of the great love he had for us,

even when we were dead in our transgressions,

brought us to life with Christ — by grace you have been saved —,

raised us up with him,

and seated us with him in the heavens in Christ Jesus, that in the ages to come

He might show the immeasurable riches of his grace in his kindness to us in Christ Jesus.

and this is not from you; it is the gift of God;

it is not from works, so no one may boast.

For we are his handiwork, created in Christ Jesus for the good works

## Gather the Faithful Under the Roof

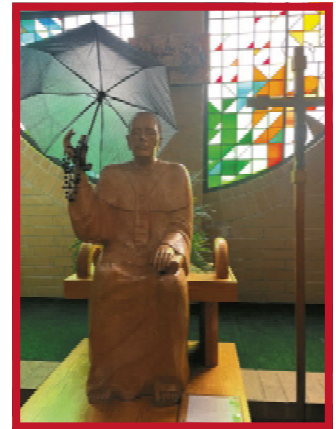
Thank you to our parishioners for your continued generosity to our "Roof Pledge" project. To date we have collected over \$133,000 in roof donations.

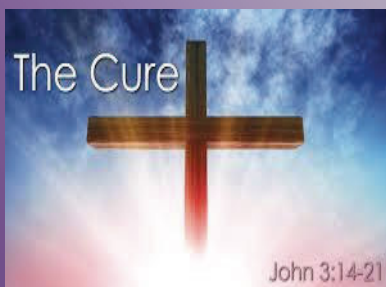

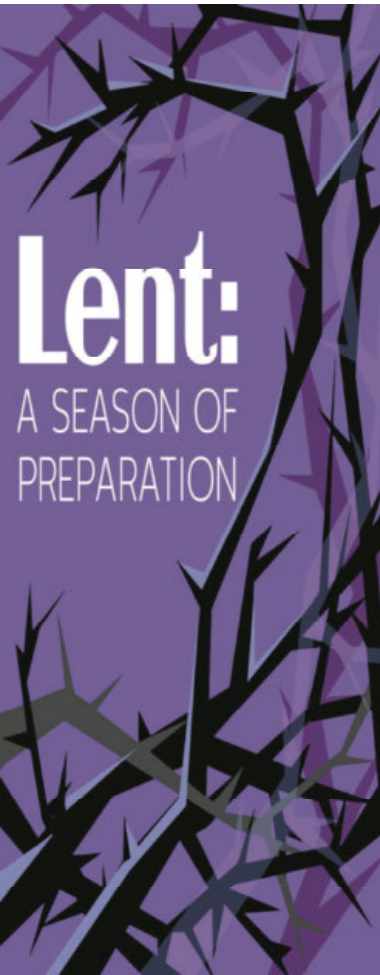

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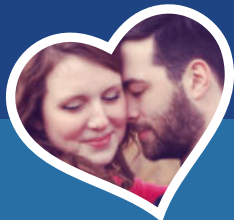
