

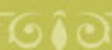

From the Pastor

Service

We associate this word with work or performance, regardless of the days of the week and regardless of the conditions that accompany it. In fact, service could be identified with a vocation - priest, doctor, teacher. But the term "service" is also associated with a need for exceptional commitment. We rarely use this term today. Rather, it is about working in special conditions, in special situations, in a special reality.

The term I am writing about has devalued for various reasons and hardly anyone uses it in colloquial speech. However, what we hear about during the Sunday Liturgy is service, service to God, with exceptional commitment, with exceptional understanding, but also with exceptional reward. Because the Service is also unique, with special rights and special duties. What is it about? It is "only" and "until" understanding what God expects from us, recognizing God as the Ruler of our consciences, our hearts, imitating His deeds, daily conversation in the form of prayer, following Christ in His way, carrying our own cross given to us at Baptism.

Commitment to this Service will allow us to recognize the paths of the Lord, let us see what He has prepared for us. We will not have to cry out, like the Israelites, "Know the Lord," for they shall all know me, from the least of them to the greatest, says the Lord; for I will forgive their iniquity, and remember their sin no more." (Jeremiah 31:34). The words that the Lord gave us through the prophet Jeremiah are completed by St. Paul: "And having been made perfect, he became the source of eternal salvation for all who obey him." (Hebrews 5:9). The service that we consider so much today is not only work. Well-understood and fulfilled service entails a constant increase in love for God and for people. After all, we are all children of God, and He, like a good Father, wants to embrace and love us all.

One could ask the question: what kind of Father gives us duties and service and only after completing our tasks will love us? Do we not burden our children with responsibilities in our own home? Do we not reward them afterwards for completed tasks? God is ahead of us in rewarding service and fulfillment of duties anyway - after all, He has given us salvation through His Son. In receiving Baptism, we are only at the beginning of the road and we already have the promise of Salvation.

It depends on us whether the words of Christ in today's Gospel will apply to us. What words? Let me remind you: "And I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all people to myself." (John 12:32).

Słowo Proboszcza

Służba

Słowo to kojarzy nam się z pracą lub jej wykonywaniem, bez względu na dni tygodnia i bez względu na uwarunkowania, jakie jej towarzyszą. W zasadzie służbę można by utożsamić z powołaniem – ksiądz, lekarz, nauczyciel. Ale z terminem „służba” kojarzy się też konieczność wyjątkowego zaangażowania. Dzisiaj z rzadka używamy tego terminu. Raczej mówi się o pracy w szczególnych warunkach, w szczególnych sytuacjach, w szczególnej rzeczywistości.

Termin, o którym piszę, z różnych powodów zdewaluował się i mało kto go używa w mowie potocznej. Jednak to, o czym słyszymy podczas Liturgii Niedzielnej, to właśnie służba, służba Bogu, z wyjątkowym zaangażowaniem, z wyjątkowym zrozumieniem, ale też z wyjątkową zapłatą. Bo i wyjątkowa to Służba, na specjalnych prawach, ze szczególnymi obowiązkami. A na czym polega? To „tylko” i „aż” zrozumienie, czego Bóg od nas oczekuje, uznanie Boga za Władcę naszych sumień, naszego serca, naśladowanie Jego czynów, rozmowa codzienna w postaci modlitwy, podążanie za Chrystusem Jego drogą, niesienie własnego krzyża danego nam przy Chrście.

Zaangażowanie w tej Służbie pozwoli nam rozpoznać ścieżki Pana, pozwoli dostrzec, co nam przygotował. Nie będziemy musieli, tak jak Izraelici, wołać «"Poznajcie Pana!" Wszyscy bowiem od najmniejszego do największego poznają Mnie – wyrocznia Pana, ponieważ odpuszczę im występki, a o grzechach ich nie będę już wspominał.» (Jr 31,34). Słowa, które Pan przekazał nam przez proroka Jeremiasza, uzupełnia św. Paweł: „A gdy wszystko wykonał, stał się sprawcą zbawienia wiecznego dla wszystkich, którzy Go słuchają” (Hbr 5,9). Służba, o której tyle dzisiaj w rozważaniach, to nie tylko praca. Dobrze rozumiana i wypełniana służba pociąga za sobą nieustanny wzrost miłości do Boga i do ludzi. Przecież wszyscy jesteśmy dziećmi Boga, a On, jak dobry Ojciec, chce nas wszystkich przyciągnąć i ukochać.

Można by zadać pytanie: co to za Ojciec, który nas obarcza obowiązkami, służbą i dopiero po wykonaniu zadań nas umiłuje? A czy my we własnym domu nie obarczamy naszych dzieci obowiązkami? Czy ich potem nie nagradzamy za wypełnione zadania? Bóg i tak wyprzedza nas pod względem nagradzania za służbę i wypełnienie obowiązków – przecież dał nam poprzez własnego Syna Zbawienie. Otrzymując Chrzest, jesteśmy dopiero na początku drogi, a już mamy obietnicę Zbawienia.

To od nas zależy, czy słowa Chrystusa z dzisiejszej Ewangelii będą nas dotyczyły. Jakie słowa? Przypomnę: „Ja, gdy zostanę nad ziemię wywyższony, przyciągnę wszystkich do siebie.” (J 12,32).

die.

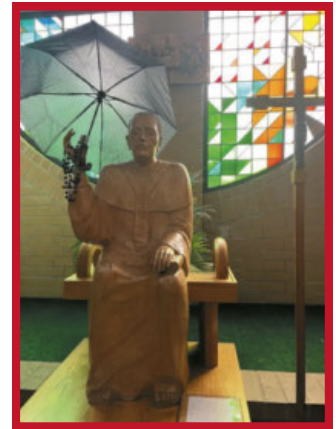


Gather the Faithful Under the Roof

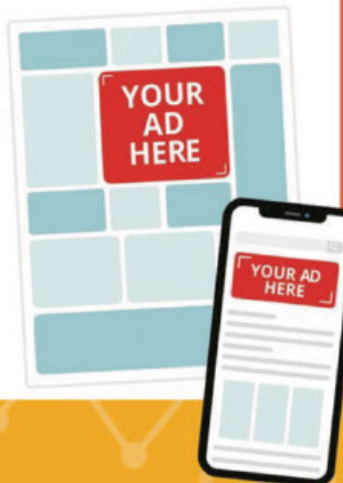

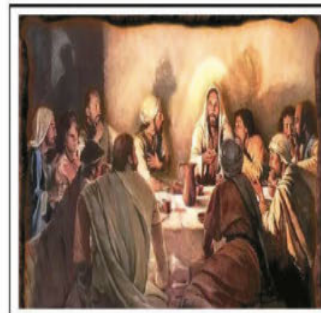

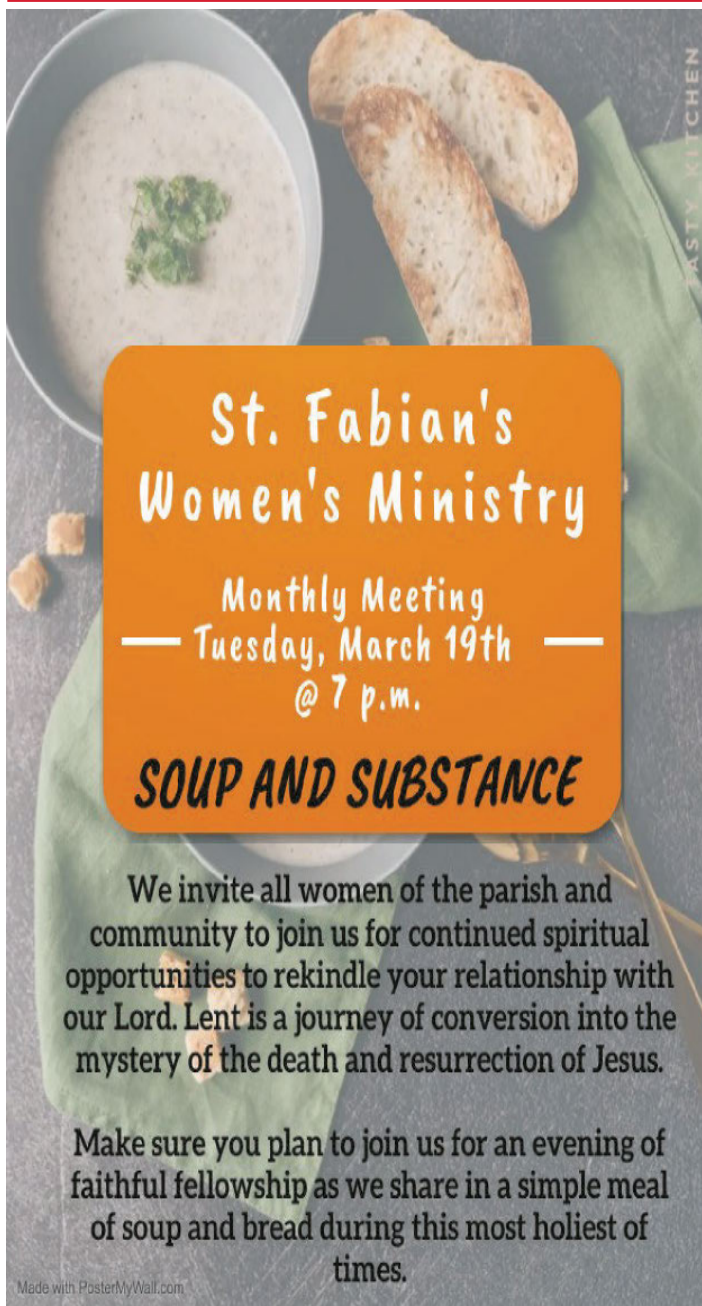
St. Vincent de Paul Food Pantry Pick-up Monday, March 25, 2024 FROM 10:00 to 11:00 a.m.

PRACTICING CATHOLIC - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

Lost in the Crowd

I write my phone number on my kids' arms when we go into large crowds at summer festivals, in case we get separated. If you think this makes me sound like a neurotic person with an overactive imagination who watches too many true crime documentaries, you would be correct. I am all of those things.

However, I am also practical, and I've endured moments of panic after looking up and briefly not being able to locate a child who has wandered off or lagged behind. The phone number, scrawled across their sunscreen-streaked skin, is a safeguard, however insignificant. It's something they can hold up to show an adult, something they can point to and say, "This is where I need to be. Help me get here."

When I reflect on my own life, it occurs to me that I was born lost. We all were. It was only in Eden that a human being ever knew what it was to be at home. In Eden, I would imagine, the feeling of safety was so natural that it was only noticed after it was gone. But original sin came like a noisy crowd to bear us away from the place we needed to be, and since that time, our human lives have played out against a backdrop of insecurity and unfamiliarity. We are cold and alone and confused. And God, our heartbroken parent, never stops seeking us, never stops calling our names.

Baptism, the etching of God's law onto our heart and soul, is not a phone number written on our arms. It's something far better — it's a homing signal, planted deep within. And it will lead us back to where we need to be.

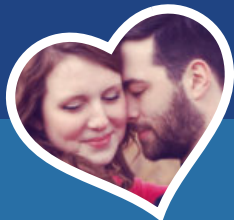
