So they brought the colt to Jesus and put their cloaks over it. And he sat on it. Many people spread their cloaks on the road, and others spread leafy branches that they had cut from the fields. - Mk 11:7-8

From the Pastor

Bottle, Pitcher, Chalice

Life is like a vessel - its contents are more important than its external form. In the description of Jesus' passion, the sign of the vessel appears three times. In Simon's home, a woman brought an alabaster bottle of a precious cosmetic and broke it at Jesus' feet; two students were sent by a Teacher to find a person with a pitcher of water; finally, Jesus himself took the chalice of wine and assured the disciples that inside the cup was his blood, his life. A bottle of a cosmetic, a pitcher of water, a chalice of Blood. A mysterious relationship takes place between these vessels, marking a path that begins with finding sin in ourselves and breaking it at the feet of the Lord, until we discover in Christ the guilty taste of God's love.

The mark of the broken alabaster vessel aroused the apostles' indignation at the waste of the oil. This waste, called *perditio*, gives a wide field of associations. This word also has a meaning: to repent, fail, destroy, and it appears when Jesus says that whoever wastes his life because of him and the Gospel will be saved (Mk 8:35). The broken bottle takes on a symbolic meaning. It illustrates the destruction of what is sinful, worldly and vain in us, as well as the repentance of our sins! A life of sin, a life of the joys of the flesh, a life of greed, vanity and satisfaction, this is the bottle that was shattered at Jesus' feet. The rejection of temptation is the waste of nard and the broken bottle of our bodily shell. One has to lose, waste, break down one's temporal forms of existence. To lose, lose this life to gain another. One has to break the alabaster body to discover the golden chalice of the soul full of the amaranth blood of Christ.

Between the darkness of earthly life and the radiance of eternity there is a path of anxiety in the search for a person with a jug of water, which is associated with washing of dirt. The hardest thing is not to be able to enjoy heaven yet, but to forget about the world's desires. Water is no longer a nard of sensuality and not yet spiritual satisfaction with the blood of Christ. Water is tears and sweat, it is often a bucket of cold water poured over the conscience.

Słowo Proboszcza

Flakonik, dzban, kielich

Życie jest jak naczynie – istotniejsza jest jego zawartość od zewnętrznej formy. W opisie męki Jezusa trzykrotnie pojawia się znak naczynia. Kobieta, w domu Szymona, przyniosła flakonik alabastrowy drogocennego kosmetyku i rozbiła go u stóp Jezusa; dwaj uczniowie zostali posłani przez Nauczyciela, aby odnaleźć człowieka z dzbanem wody; wreszcie sam Jezus wziął kielich wina i zapewnił uczniów, że wewnątrz tego pucharu jest Jego krew, Jego życie. Flakonik kosmetyku, dzban wody, kielich Krwi. Pomiędzy tymi naczyniami zachodzi tajemniczy związek, wyznaczający nam drogę rozpoczynającą się od odnalezienia w sobie grzechu i rozbicia go u stóp Pana, aż do odkrycia w Chrystusie winnego smaku miłości Boga.

Znak rozbitego alabastrowego naczynia wzbudził w apostołach oburzenie spowodowane zmarnowaniem olejku. To zmarnowanie, nazwane *perditio*, daje szerokie pole skojarzeń. Słowo to ma również znaczenie: odpokutować, przegrać, zniszczyć, i pojawia się, kiedy Jezus mówi o tym, że kto zmarnuje swoje życie z Jego powodu i Ewangelii, uzyska zbawienie (Mk 8,35). Stłuczony flakonik nabiera więc znaczenia symbolicznego. Ilustruje zniszczenie tego, co w nas grzeszne, światowe i próżne, jak również dokonanie pokuty za nasze winy! Życie w grzechu, życie korzystające z uciech ciała, życie w chciwości, w próżności i satysfakcji, to właśnie ów flakonik, który u stóp Jezusa został roztrzaskany. Odrzucenie kuszenia to właśnie zmarnowanie nardu i rozbity flakonik naszej cielesnej powłoki. Trzeba stracić, zmarnować, rozbić swoje doczesne kształty istnienia. Przegrać, zgubić to życie, by zyskać inne. Trzeba rozbić alabastrowe ciało, by odkryć złoty kielich duszy pełen amarantowej krwi Chrystusa.

Pomiędzy mrokiem doczesności i blaskiem wieczności jest droga niepokoju w poszukiwaniu człowieka z dzbanem z wodą, która kojarzy się z obmyciem z brudu. Najtrudniej jest nie cieszyć się jeszcze niebem, a już nie zapominać o pożądaniach tego świata. Woda to już nie nard zmysłowości i jeszcze nie duchowe zaspokojenie krwią Chrystusa. Woda to łyż i pot, to często kubek zimnej wody wylany na sumienie.

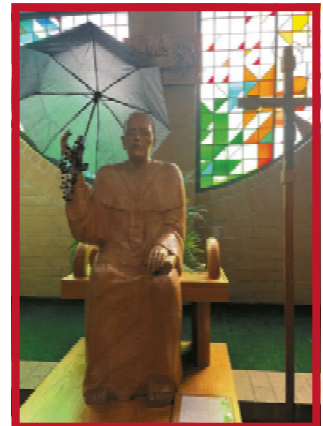
Gather the Faithful Under the Roof
