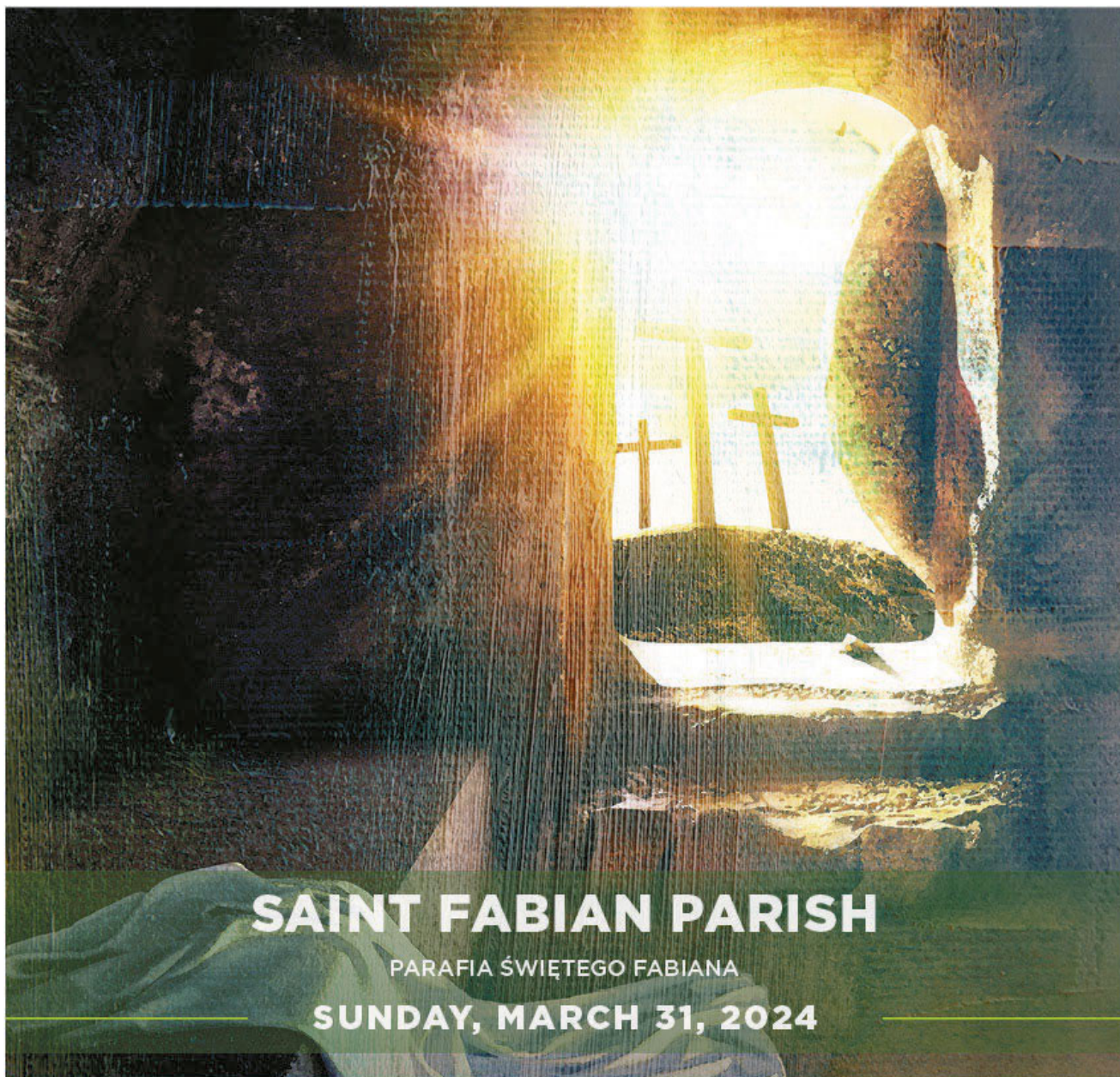

From the Pastor

He Saw and Believed

The spiritual experience of Easter strengthens our relationship with God. It makes us able to reflect on the transience of life, on our past and future. For on Earth, moving between life and death, between victories and defeats, we need incentives to notice what was right and good in our lives and in the decisions we make, and what was wrong and bad.

The joy of today is experiencing the day of a new life, the Lord's Resurrection. And the words of Pope Francis should make us realize that next to us are those who need our help and prayers. The words spoken by Pope Francis, but also spoken by each priest during each Holy Mass: "Through Christ, with Christ and in Christ" remind us of the most important truth that we should live as the Lord showed us. Through his Resurrection, Jesus shows us what awaits us after passing from one form of life to another, under one condition, however, that is, under the condition of understanding the three main principles of our life: FAITH, HOPE and LOVE.

The words: "God raised him on the third day and allowed him to appear, not to all the people but to us who were chosen by God as witnesses, and who ate and drank with him after he rose from the dead. He commanded us to preach to the people and to testify that he is the one ordained by God as judge of the living and the dead." (Acts 10:40-42) exude hope, giving us strength to fight our daily difficulties, and they do not allow us to forget the ultimate goal of our struggle.

Joy, joy and joy again! May the awareness that thanks to the sacrifice of Jesus Christ we will also reach our destiny, that is, what God the Father has promised us, strengthen our faith. The main message of the Gospel is faith, but indirectly also understanding, which goes hand in hand, because we understand through faith, and by believing we understand the truth of today, the day of the Resurrection.

It is our task to combine everyday life with a deep spiritual life. If we add to this: care for the smallest, the poorest and the sick, it turns out that we have a great task ahead of us. Can we cope? With the Risen One - yes.

Słowo Proboszcza

Ujrzał i uwierzył

Duchowe przeżywanie Świąt umacnia naszą więź z Bogiem, powoduje, iż jesteśmy w stanie podjąć refleksję nad przemijalnością życia, nad naszą przeszłością i przyszłością. Bowiem na ziemi, poruszając się pomiędzy życiem i śmiercią, pomiędzy zwycięstwami i porażkami, potrzebujemy bodźców, by zauważyć, co w naszym życiu i decyzjach było właściwe i dobre, a co niedobre, a czasami złe.

Radość dzisiejszego dnia to przeżywanie dnia nowego życia, Zmartwychwstania Pańskiego. Zaś słowa papieża Franciszka uzmysłować nam powinny, iż obok nas są ci, którzy potrzebują naszej pomocy i modlitwy. Słowa wypowiedziane przez Franciszka, ale także wypowiedziane przez każdego kapłana podczas każdej Mszy Świętej: „Przez Chrystusa, z Chrystusem i w Chrystusie” przypominają nam najważniejszą prawdę, iż żyć powinniśmy tak, jak pokazywał nam Pan. Jezus, poprzez swoje Zmartwychwstanie, pokazuje, co nas czeka po przejściu z jednej formy życia do drugiej, pod jednym wszakże warunkiem, a mianowicie pod warunkiem zrozumienia trzech głównych zasad naszego życia: WIARY, NADZIEI i MIŁOŚCI.

Słowa: „Bóg wskrzesił Go trzeciego dnia i pozwolił Mu ukazać się nie całemu ludowi, ale nam, wybranym uprzednio przez Boga na świadków, którzyśmy z Nim jedli i pili po Jego zmartwychwstaniu. On nam rozkazał ogłosić ludowi i dać świadectwo, że Bóg ustanowił Go sędzią żywych i umarłych.” (Dz 10,40-42) emanują nadzieją, dodającą nam sił do walki z codziennymi trudnościami, i nie pozwalają zapomnieć o ostatecznym celu naszej walki.

Radość, radość i raz jeszcze radość! Niech świadomość tego, iż dzięki poświęceniu się Jezusa Chrystusa i my osiągniemy nasze przeznaczenie, czyli to, co nam obiecał Bóg Ojciec, wzmacnia naszą wiarę. Głównym przekazem Ewangelii jest wiara, ale pośrednio i zrozumienie, co zresztą idzie w parze, bowiem rozumiemy poprzez wiarę, a wierząc pojmujemy prawdę dnia dzisiejszego, dnia Zmartwychwstania.

Połączyć życie codzienne z głębokim życiem duchowym to nasze zadanie. Jeśli dodamy do tego dbałość o najmniejszych, najuboższych i chorych, to okaże się, że przed nami stoi wielkie zadanie. Czy podołamy? Ze Zmartwychwstałym – tak.

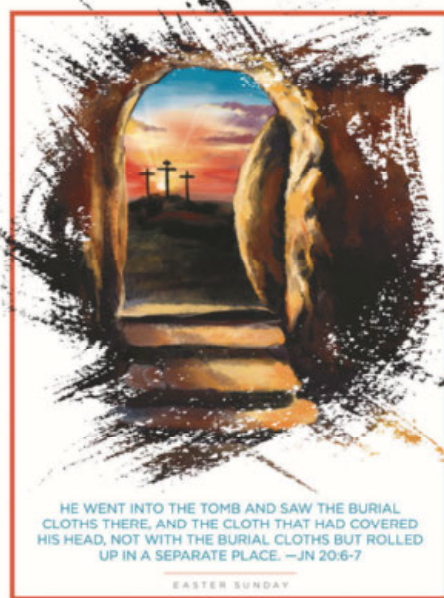
Therefore, let us celebrate the feast, not with the old

 understand the
 Scripture
 that he had to
 rise from the
 dead.

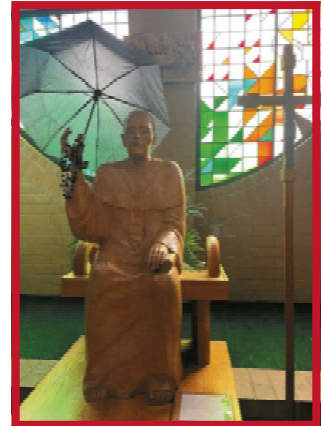


Gather the Faithful Under the Roof

The Sunday after Easter is Divine Mercy Sunday!



How should we prepare for this great Feast of Mercy?

Jesus told St. Faustina that this Feast of Mercy would be a very special day when **"all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened"**. (Diary 699) Our Lord made a great promise to all those souls who would go to Confession and then receive Him in Holy Communion on the Feast of Mercy, on the Sunday after Easter, which is now called Divine Mercy Sunday throughout the Catholic Church.

Jesus promised that **"The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain the complete forgiveness of sins and punishment."** (Diary 699) He went on to say **"I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My Mercy."** (Diary 1109)

We want to encourage everyone to take advantage of this incredible promise and the additional Plenary Indulgence on this great Feast of Mercy "Divine Mercy Sunday". We want you to benefit fully from these promises, and we also want you to notify all of your family and friends about them too and urge them to return to the practice of their faith!

The Image of The Divine Mercy, which Our Lord requested to be solemnly blessed and venerated on this day, will be on display in our church. Pope John Paul II said that the image portrays the Risen Jesus Christ bringing Mercy to the whole world. Our Lord said **"I want the image to be solemnly blessed on the first Sunday after Easter, and I want it to be venerated publicly so that every soul may know about it. I promise that the soul that will venerate this image will not perish"**. (Diary 341, 48) Please take the time to visit with this Image of The Divine Mercy and venerate Jesus after live-streaming of our Masses on April 19th.

Jesus said to St. Faustina **"I am offering people a vessel with which they are to keep coming for graces to the fountain of mercy. That vessel is this image with the signature: Jesus, I trust in You"**. (Diary 327) **"The two rays denote Blood and Water. The pale ray stands for the Water which makes souls righteous. The red ray stands for the Blood which is the life of souls. These two rays issued forth from the very depths of My tender mercy when My agonized Heart was opened by a lance on the cross. ...Happy is the one who will dwell in their shelter, for the just hand of God shall not lay hold of him."** (Diary 299)

About the feast day "Divine Mercy Sunday", Jesus said **"...tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon the souls who approach the Fount of My Mercy. On that day all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet.... Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy"**. (Diary 699)

During this difficult time of the Covid19 Virus, Pope Francis has authorized "Spiritual Confession." Jesus said **"When you go to confession, to this fountain of My mercy, the Blood and Water which came forth from My Heart always flows down upon your soul..."** and **"Every time you go to confession, immerse yourself entirely in My mercy with great trust, so that I may pour the bounty of My grace upon your soul."**

It is required of all Catholics to confess their serious sins at least once every year. If you haven't yet met this obligation then take advantage of this outstanding opportunity to receive an outpouring of an ocean of graces that Jesus promises on this day. The Church allows for one to go to Confession for up to about 20 days, before or after Divine Mercy Sunday.

Note: St. Fabian Church has Relic's of both Saint Faustina and Saint John Paul II which will be displayed on our Altar during Adoration of the Divine Mercy on Divine Mercy Sunday, April 7, 2024. Live-streaming of this Adoration will begin after the Sunday Masses are over until 6:00 p.m.

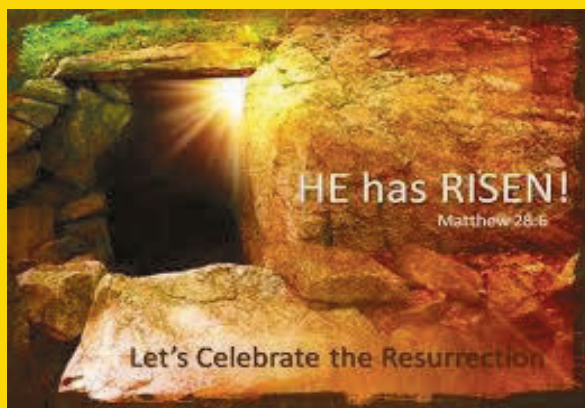

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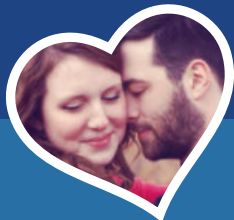
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
