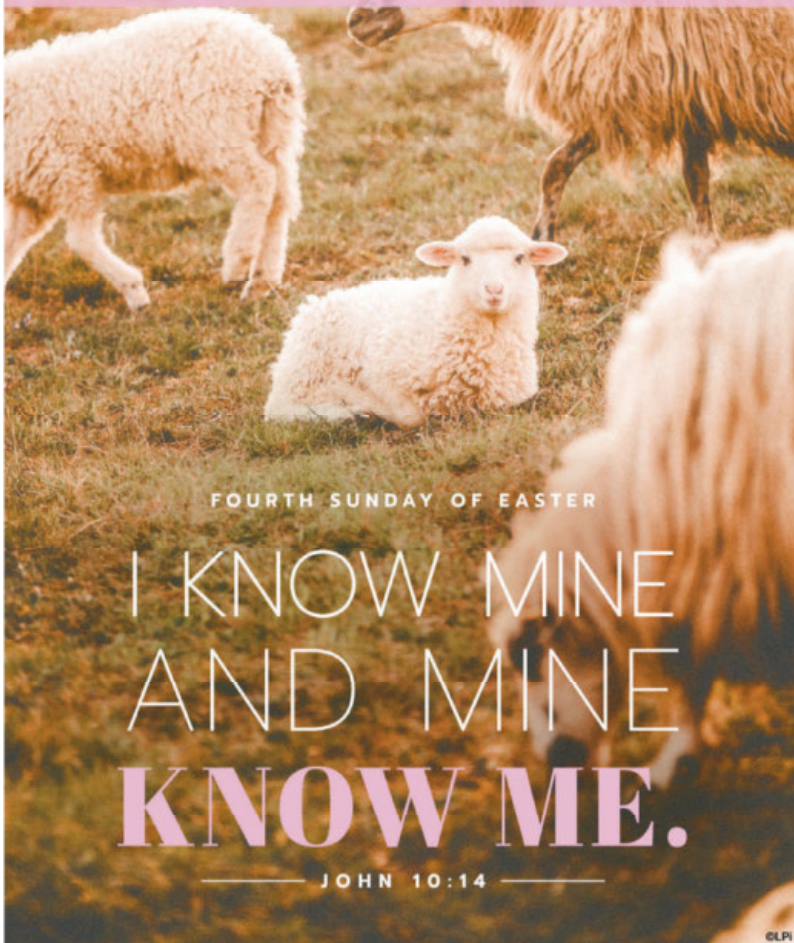

From the Pastor

Good Shepherd

Our concern is to constantly strengthen our relationship with Christ the Good Shepherd, always, in all circumstances of our life, regardless of whether we are at "calm waters" or we are to walk through the "dark valley".

We need deeper reflection to discover God's call to each of us. One must hear this call and accept it with all their heart and life. After all, the Lord is always our Shepherd, so we should also be sheep that always belong to Him.

Today's Sunday invites us to a special prayer for priests. The priest guides us on the way to eternal life, the way that leads through the living gate that is Jesus Christ. It is a great responsibility and effort. Therefore, let us surround our priests with prayer and let us entrust their ministry to Mary, Mother of the Good Shepherd. It is important that Christ's flock has enough shepherds, otherwise it will suffer neglect and may even become scattered.

The readings make us aware of the path and under which guidance we are to walk through life. By sacrificing himself for all, Christ united us on the way to Glory. Taking on his shoulders the sins of the whole world, he has united us in love. He describes himself as the Good Shepherd who does not forget his flock. Saying, "I have other sheep that do not belong to this fold. I must bring them also, and they will listen to my voice. So there will be one flock, one shepherd." (John 10:16), reminds us that at the end of history all people will be fully united under one Shepherd, who will be He, Jesus Christ, for "There is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among mortals by which we must be saved." (Acts 4:12).

The only question is: are we able to read our tasks and the obligations arising from them, and can we fulfill them?

Słowo Proboszcza

Dobry Pasterz

Bardzo istotna jest nasza troska o nieustanne wzmacnianie więzi z Chrystusem Dobrym Pasterzem, i to zawsze, w każdych okolicznościach naszego życia, niezależnie od tego, czy znajdujemy się nad „spokojnymi wodami”, czy też przyszło nam iść „ciemną doliną”.

Trzeba nam głębszej refleksji, aby odkryć Boże wezwanie skierowane do każdego z nas. Trzeba to wezwanie usłyszeć i przyjąć sercem i życiem. Wszak Pan jest zawsze naszym Pasterzem, więc i my powinniśmy być owcami zawsze należącymi do Niego.

Dzisiejsza niedziela zachęca nas do szczególnej modlitwy za kapłanów. Kapłan prowadzi nas drogą do życia wiecznego, drogą wiodącą przez żywą bramę, którą jest Jezus Chrystus. To wielka odpowiedzialność i trud. Dlatego otaczajmy naszych kapłanów modlitwą i zawierzajmy ich posłudze Maryi, Matce Dobrego Pasterza. Ważne jest, aby Chrystusowa owczarnia miała wystarczającą liczbę pasterzy, inaczej ucierpi, gdyż będzie zaniedbana, a nawet może się rozproszyć.

Czytania uzmysławiają nam, jaką drogą i pod jakim przewodnictwem mamy kroczyć przez życie. Chrystus, poświęcając się za wszystkich, zjednoczył nas w drodze do Chwały. Biorąc na swoje barki grzechy całego świata, zjednoczył nas w miłości. Sam siebie określa mianem Dobrego Pasterza, który nie zapomina o swojej trzodzie. Mówiąc „Mam także inne owce, które nie są z tej owczarni. I te muszę przyprowadzić i będą słuchać głosu mego, i nastanie jedna owczarnia, jeden pasterz.” (J 10,16), przypomina nam, że na końcu dziejów nastąpi pełne zjednoczenie wszystkich ludzi pod jednym Pasterzem, którym będzie On, Jezus Chrystus, bowiem „nie ma w żadnym innym zbawienia, gdyż nie dano ludziom pod niebem żadnego innego imienia, w którym moglibyśmy być zbawieni.” (Dz 4,12).

Pozostaje tylko pytanie: czy jesteśmy w stanie odczytać nasze zadania i wynikające z nich obowiązki i czy potrafimy je wypełnić?

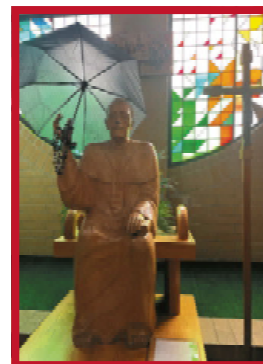

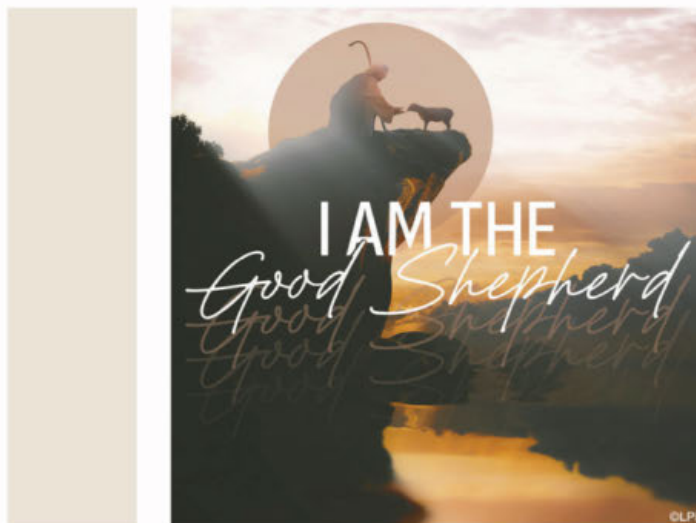

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Gospel Meditation

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

Recently I was with my little dog Libby at a retreat center in the Arizona desert. I sat in a chair near a ravine filled with shrubs. Unbeknownst to me, Libby wandered down there and disappeared. Suddenly an animal's wild shriek erupted from the area. Without thinking, I bolted down into the ravine fully expecting to see coyotes, javelinas, or rattlesnakes. I didn't care. I desperately wanted to get Libby out of there, without any self-regard. Before I could face whatever danger lay hidden, my dog blissfully trotted out from an entirely different area, utterly unaware that I had (quite heroically) just placed my life on the line.

When the adrenaline wore off, I thought to myself: how far would I have been willing to go to save her? I don't know. But I do know, if I had literally died, my friends and family would have certainly thought me insane for dying for a dog. No offense, Libby.

How passionately Jesus wants us to know him and his willingness to die for us! This week he says, **"I know my own and my own know me,"** and **"I lay down my life for the sheep."** Here we encounter an insanely excessive love for us. Christianity is a relationship and not simply a religion or ethical code. In Jesus, God rescues and saves us. He laid down his life for you and me — and he has taken it up again. So often we are like Libby — blissfully ignorant of the reality of both our spiritual danger and his saving love. This Easter season, the risen Jesus calls us to be more conscious than ever before about his love. He never ceases to lay down his life for us.

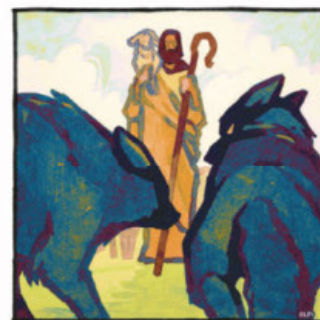

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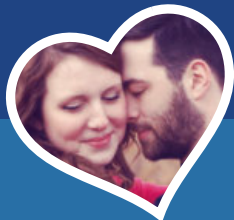
