From the Pastor -Słowo Proboszcza

The Fruits of Our Faith

While living and creating, we do not even think about the fruits of our actions. Often, we do not even think about the goal of our journey, because living in the moment we simply do not notice it. We realize that our life is a struggle for survival, day by day, hour by hour.

It often happens that we break open doors, see no other possibilities, see only our imaginary goal, do not see intermediate goals, and sometimes we do not even see the main goal, which should be Jesus Christ. It is he who opens the door for us and offers us life and service.

It is enough to listen to the words of Scripture and understand what doors are opening before us and what propositions await us. The doors of the Church are always open to us, and the risen Christ, who freed us from our sins through the revelation of the truth, offers us a bright future. In accepting this truth, "let us love, not in word or speech, but in truth and action. And by this we will know that we are from the truth and will reassure our hearts before him." (1 John 3:18-19). By remaining in the truth, we will not only calm our hearts, consciences and souls, we will not only see the proper goal of our journey, but we will also reach out to the doors opened to us through participation in the Eucharist, with an eternal invitation to joy and growth in faith, in God.

Do we adequately understand the Gospel comparison of us to a branch that grows and bears much fruit? After all, we are fruit, hopefully not wormy, not withered - such are thrown away or burned, for what is the benefit of a withered bush that bears no fruit.

"If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, ask for whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. My Father is glorified by this, that you bear much fruit and become my disciples." (John 15:7-8). I want to live and remain in presence, I want to be a disciple, learn from the Lord love, mercy, goodness, respect for others, because then it will be better and easier for me to live.

Owoce naszej wiary

Żyjąc i tworząc, nie zastanawiamy się nawet nad tym, jakie owoce przynoszą nasze działania. Nierzadko nawet nie zastanawiamy się nad celem naszej drogi, bo żyjąc chwilą po prostu go nie zauważamy. Zdajemy sobie sprawę, że nasze życie to walka o przetrwanie, z dnia na dzień, z godziny na godzinę.

Często zdarza się, że wyważamy już otwarte drzwi, nie widzimy innych możliwości, widzimy tylko nasz wyimaginowany cel, nie dostrzegamy celów pośrednich, a czasami nawet nie widzimy celu głównego, jakim powinien być Jezus Chrystus. To właśnie On otwiera nam drzwi i daje propozycje życia, posługi.

Wystarczy wsłuchać się w słowa Pisma Świętego i zrozumieć, jakie drzwi otwierają się przed nami i jakie to propozycje na nas czekają. Drzwi Kościoła są dla nas zawsze otwarte, a propozycje jasnej przyszłości daje nam Chrystus Zmartwychwstały, który wyzwolił nas z grzechów przez Objawienie Prawdy. Przyjmując tę prawdę „nie miłujmy słowem i językiem, ale czynem i prawdą. Po tym poznamy, że jesteśmy z prawdy, i uspokoimy przed Nim nasze serce.” (1 J 3,18-19). Pozostając w prawdzie, nie tylko uspokoimy nasze serca, sumienia i duszę, nie tylko będziemy widzieli właściwy cel naszej wędrówki, lecz także dojrniemy do otwieranych nam przez udział w Eucharystii Drzwi z wiecznym zaproszeniem do radości i wzrastania w wierze, w Bogu.

Czy odpowiednio rozumiemy ewangeliczne porównanie nas do latorośli pnącej się i przynoszącej owoc obfity? W końcu jesteśmy owocami, oby tylko nie robaczywymi, nie uschniętymi – takie się wyrzuca lub pali, bo cóż za korzyść z uschniętego krzewu, który nie przynosi owoców.

„Jeżeli we Mnie trwać będziecie, a słowa moje w was, poproście, o cokolwiek chcecie, a to wam się spełni. Ojciec mój przez to dozna chwały, że owoc obfity przyniesiecie i staniecie się moimi uczniami.” (J 15,7-8). Chcę żyć i trwać w obecności, chcę być uczniem, uczyć się od Pana miłości, miłosierdzia, dobroci, poszanowania dla innych, bo wtedy lepiej i łatwiej będzie mi się żyć.

 and with the consolation of the Holy Spirit it grew in numbers.

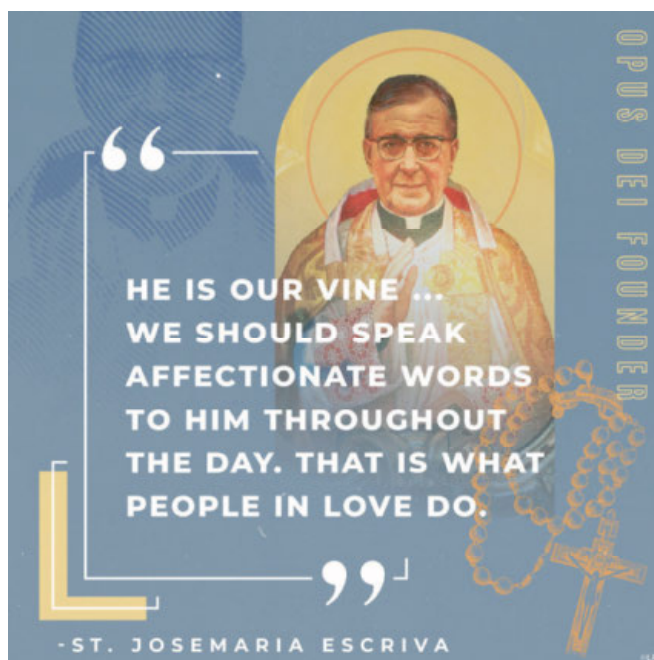
Reading 2: 1 John 3:18-24

 that you bear much fruit and become my disciples."



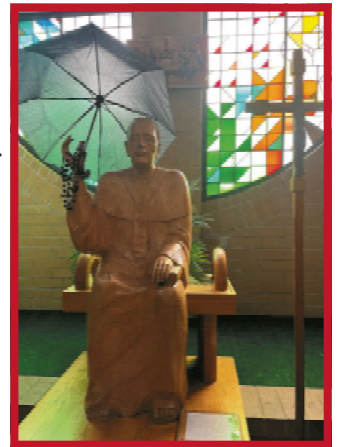
Gather the Faithful Under the Roof

PIERWSZE CZYTANIE

Dz 4, 26-31

Kiedy Szaweł przybył do Jeruzalem, próbował przyłączyć się do uczniów, lecz wszyscy bali się go, nie wierząc, że jest uczniem.

1 J 3, 18-24

J 15, 1-8

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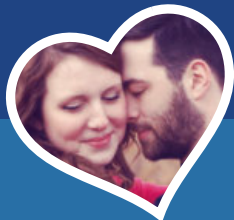
