Ritual?

Invariably, we repeat the ritual every year, we have the same route, sometimes with slight changes, we have four altars where the Gospels of the four Evangelists are read. The altars are decorated and adorned with trees, flowers, and inscriptions. Sometimes, even beautiful rugs of flowers are laid.

While praying and singing, let us also think about those for whom the procession and the feast of the Body and Blood of Christ have become just folklore, a spectacle or a sensation worth showing to children. Let us pray for them to think about their soul and eternal life, and not only about consumption and worldly joys. Let us treat this feast as our thanksgiving for everything that happens to us, what touches us, hurts us and makes us happy. Let us think how many of those whom we have met more than once will never participate in this feast with us again, because they have departed to the Lord. How many others, due to the deterioration of health, cannot be with us personally, but only spiritually. And how many, because of financial problems, have left us and our environment to seek "better life" somewhere else.

Let us ask God, apologize to Him and thank Him for the opportunity to participate in the Feast of the Body and Blood of the Lord, our nourishment that brings us closer to Heaven.

Rytuał?

Nieźmiennie, co roku powtarzamy rytuał, mamy taką samą trasę, może czasem z małymi zmianami, mamy cztery ołtarze, przy których czytane są Ewangelie czterech Ewangelistów. Ołtarze są ozdobione i przystrojone w drzewka i kwiaty, napisy. W niektórych miejscowościach układane są piękne dywany kwiatowe.

Modląc się i śpiewając, pomyślmy również o tych, dla których procesja i święto Ciała i Krwi Chrystusa stały się tylko folklorem, widowiskiem lub sensacją godną pokazania dzieciom. Pomódlmy się za nich, aby pomyśleli o swojej duszy i życiu wiecznym, a nie tylko o konsumpcji i radościach doczesnych. Potraktujmy to Święto jako nasze dziękczynienie za wszystko, co nas spotyka, dotyka, boli i cieszy. Pomyślmy, ilu spośród tych, których nieraz spotykaliśmy, już nigdy razem z nami nie będzie uczestniczyć w tym święcie, bowiem odeszli do Pana. Ilu innych, z racji pogorszenia zdrowia, nie może być z nami osobiście, lecz tylko duchowo. A ilu z powodu problemów finansowych opuściło nas i nasze środowisko, by poza granicami kraju szukać „lepszego życia”.

Prośmy Boga, przepraszajmy Go i dziękujmy Mu za możliwość uczestniczenia w Święcie Ciała i Krwi Pańskiej, naszego pożywienia, które przybliża nas do Nieba.

Sunday Readings

FIRST READING: Ex 24:3-8

When Moses came to the people
and related all the words and ordinances of the LORD,
they all answered with one voice,
“We will do everything that the LORD has told us.”
Moses then wrote down all the words of the LORD and,
rising early the next day,
he erected at the foot of the mountain an altar
and twelve pillars for the twelve tribes of Israel.
Then, having sent certain young men of the Israelites
to offer holocausts and sacrifice young bulls
as peace offerings to the LORD,
Moses took half of the blood and put it in large bowls;
the other half he splashed on the altar.
Taking the book of the covenant, he read it aloud to the people,
who answered, “All that the LORD has said, we will heed and do.”
Then he took the blood and sprinkled it on the people, saying,
“This is the blood of the covenant
which the LORD has made with you
in accordance with all these words of his.”

SECOND READING: Heb 9:11-15

Brothers and sisters:
When Christ came as high priest
of the good things that have come to be,
passing through the greater and more perfect tabernacle
not made by hands, that is, not belonging to this creation,
he entered once for all into the sanctuary,
not with the blood of goats and calves
but with his own blood, thus obtaining eternal redemption.
For if the blood of goats and bulls
and the sprinkling of a heifer's ashes
can sanctify those who are defiled
so that their flesh is cleansed,
how much more will the blood of Christ,
who through the eternal spirit offered himself unblemished to God,
cleanse our consciences from dead works
to worship the living God.
For this reason he is mediator of a new covenant:
since a death has taken place for deliverance
from transgressions under the first covenant,
those who are called may receive the promised eternal inheritance.

GOSPEL: Mk 14:12-16, 22-26

On the first day of the Feast of Unleavened Bread,
when they sacrificed the Passover lamb,
his disciples said to him,
“Where do you want us to go
and prepare for you to eat the Passover?”
He sent two of his disciples and said to them,

“Go into the city and a man will meet you,
carrying a jar of water.

Follow him.

Wherever he enters, say to the master of the house,
‘The Teacher says, “Where is my guest room
where I may eat the Passover with my disciples?”’

Then he will show you a large upper room furnished and ready.

Make the preparations for us there.”

The disciples then went off, entered the city,
and found it just as he had told them;
and they prepared the Passover.

While they were eating,
he took bread, said the blessing,
broke it, and gave it to them, and said,
“Take it; this is my body.”

Then he took a cup, gave thanks, and gave it to them,
and they all drank from it.

He said to them,

“This is my blood of the covenant,
which will be shed for many.

Amen, I say to you,

I shall not drink again the fruit of the vine
until the day when I drink it new in the kingdom of God.”

Then, after singing a hymn,
they went out to the Mount of Olives.”

Czytania na Niedzielę

PIERWSZE CZYTANIE Wj 24, 3-8

Mojżesz wrócił z góry Synaj i obwieścił ludowi wszystkie słowa Pana i wszystkie Jego polecenia. Wtedy cały lud odpowiedział jednogłośnie: «Wszystkie słowa, jakie powiedział Pan, wypełnimy».

Spisał więc Mojżesz wszystkie słowa Pana. Nazajutrz wcześnie rano zbudował ołtarz u stóp góry i postawił dwanaście stel, stosownie do liczby dwunastu szczepów Izraela. Potem polecił młodzieńcom izraelskim złożyć Panu ofiarę całopalną i ofiarę biesiadną z cielców.

Mojżesz zaś wziął połowę krwi i wlał ją do czar, a drugą połowę krwi skropił ołtarz.

Wtedy wziął Księgę Przymierza i czytał ją głośnie ludowi. I oświadczyli: «Wszystko, co powiedział Pan, uczynimy i będziemy posłuszni».

Mojżesz wziął krew i pokropił nią lud, mówiąc: «Oto krew przymierza, które Pan zawarł z wami na podstawie wszystkich tych słów».

Drugie Czytanie Hbr 9, 11-15

Bracia:

Chrystus, zjawiwszy się jako arcykapłan dóbr przyszłych, przez wyższy i doskonalszy, i nie ręką — to jest nie na tym świecie — uczyniony przybytek, ani nie przez krew kozłów i cielców, lecz przez własną krew wszedł raz na zawsze do Miejsca Świętego i osiągnął wieczne odkupienie.

Jeśli bowiem krew kozłów i cielców oraz popiół z krowy, którymi skrapia się zanieczyszczonych, sprawiają oczyszczenie ciała, to o ile bardziej krew Chrystusa, który przez Ducha wiecznego złożył Bogu samego siebie jako nieskalaną ofiarę, oczyści wasze sumienia z martwych uczynków, abyście służyć mogli Bogu żywemu.

I dlatego jest pośrednikiem Nowego Przymierza, ażeby przez śmierć, poniesioną dla odkupienia przestępstw popełnionych za pierwszego przymierza, ci, którzy są wezwani do wiecznego dziedzictwa, dostąpili spełnienia obietnicy.

EWANGELIA Mk 14, 12-16. 22-26

W pierwszy dzień Przaśników, kiedy ofiarowywano Paschę, zapytali Jezusa Jego uczniowie: «Gdzie chcesz, żebyśmy przygotowali Ci spożywanie Paschy?»

I posłał dwóch spośród swoich uczniów z tym poleceniem: «Idźcie do miasta, a spotka was człowiek niosący dzban wody. Idźcie za nim i tam, gdzie wejdzie, powiedzcie gospodarzowi: Nauczyciel pyta: Gdzie jest dla Mnie izba, w której mógłbym spożyć Paschę z moimi uczniami? On wskaże wam na górze salę dużą, usłaną i gotową. Tam przygotujecie dla nas».

Uczniowie wybrali się i przyszedli do miasta, a tam znaleźli wszystko, tak jak im powiedział, i przygotowali Paschę.

A gdy jedli, wziął chleb, odmówił błogosławieństwo, połamał i dał im, mówiąc: «Bierzcie, to jest Ciało moje». Potem wziął kielich i odmówiwszy dziękczynienie, dał im, i pili z niego wszyscy. I rzekł do nich: «To jest moja Krew Przymierza, która za wielu będzie wylana. Zaprawdę, powiadam wam: Odtąd nie będę już pił napoju z owocu winnego krzewu aż do owego dnia, kiedy pić będę go nowy w królestwie Bożym».

Po odśpiewaniu hymnu wyszli w stronę Góry Oliwnej.

Corpus Christi

What we celebrate

Corpus Christi is a feast day with the sole purpose of focusing on the Holy Eucharist.



When we celebrate

Officially the Thursday after Trinity Sunday. However, it's most often celebrated on the Sunday after Trinity Sunday.

Ways we celebrate

- A procession of the Eucharist around your parish.
- Eucharistic Adoration after Mass.
- Praying a traditional Catholic prayer called "Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament" at the end of Mass and singing songs about the Eucharist.
- If the Feast of Corpus Christi is a public holiday where you live, you may see a Eucharist procession (sometimes by candlelight) happening in the streets.

History

Saint Juliana of Liege (1193-1258), who had a great reverence for the Blessed Sacrament, began the cause for the feast day of Corpus Christi. This day would be apart from Holy Thursday when the Church focuses on not only the Eucharist but the washing of the feet, ordained priesthood, and Jesus in agony in the Garden of Gethsemane. Saint Juliana was motivated by a recurring vision of the Church as a full moon with one dark spot, which she interpreted as the absence of a specific reverence to the Holy Eucharist. In her later years, she gained the support of Jacques Pantaléon, at the time Archdeacon of Liège, and other Church leaders. Pantaléon was later elected Pope Urban IV and went on to establish the Feast of Corpus Christi.

Homework

Spend some time in prayer today asking for a greater ability to see the face of Christ in others. (If you're Catholic, spend that prayer time in front of the Blessed Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist). Then say a quick prayer for five random people that you pass throughout your day.

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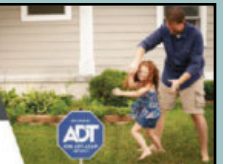
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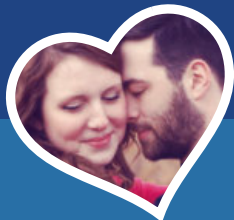
