From the Pastor

The Right Shepherd

The shepherd is responsible for the sheep entrusted to him, for their health, for their pastures, for his herd and for his wards. He fights against evil forces, whether they are animals or people who could threaten the flock - the herd. It is important that a good shepherd knows all his pupils and can guarantee their safety and a peaceful life.

In today's Word of God, we hear about the shepherds described in the book of Jeremiah. The Lord warns all those who are wrongly undertaking their duties towards the herd, announcing at the same time the tasks of the leaders of the people: "Woe to the shepherds who are destroying and scattering the sheep of my pasture!" declares the Lord. Therefore this is what the Lord, the God of Israel, says to the shepherds who tend my people." (Jeremiah 23:1-2) This is an obvious message that shows us Priests as those who lead us to God, who instruct us, who surround us with spiritual care, offer advice and love.

Are we able to read the announcements addressed to us? For in the continuation of the readings we hear the announcement, "I will place shepherds over them who will tend them, and they will no longer be afraid or terrified, nor will any be missing." (Jeremiah 23:4). So these words are directed not only to the shepherds, our guides, but also to us, that we may be strong in faith, that we have spiritual protection, that the right people lead us on the way to God, to eternity. It is good that in today's readings we hear about shepherds, because we must be aware that we need guides and - in order to guide us - we should respect and listen to them. Both the Shepherd and the Guide are defined as our mentors, those who guide us, prompt us, and are responsible for us spiritually, *In Persona Christi*.

The first Shepherd and Priest was Jesus Christ. It is He who continues to guide us and teaches us about faith, about God the Father, about our future, because "He came and preached peace to you who were far away and peace to those who were near. For through him we both have access to the Father by one Spirit." (Ephesians 2:17-18). In the twenty-first century, unlike in the times of Christ, we have this opportunity to care more for our Shepherds, how they care for us, let us listen to the words during the Liturgy of the Word, Homilies, and Pastoral Letters.

Właściwy Pasterz

Pasterz, odpowiedzialny jest za powierzone mu owce, za ich zdrowie, pastwiska, dba o swoje stado, o swoje podopieczne. Walczy ze złymi siłami, zwierzętami, czy ludźmi, którzy mogliby zagrozić trzodzie – stadu. Ważnym jest by dobry pasterz znał wszystkie swoje podopieczne, mógł im zagwarantować bezpieczeństwo i spokojne życie.

W dzisiejszym Słowie Bożym słyszymy o pasterzach opisywanych w księdze Jeremiasza. Pan ostrzega wszystkich tych, którzy źle podejmują swoje obowiązki względem stada, jednocześnie zapowiadając, jakie to zadania mają przewodnicy ludu: "Biada pasterzom, którzy prowadzą do zguby i rozpraszają owce mojego pastwiska – wyrocznia Pana. Dlatego to mówi Pan, Bóg Izraela, o pasterzach, którzy mają paść mój naród" (Jr 23 ,1-2). Jest to oczywisty przekaz, wskazujący nam Kapłanów, jako tych, którzy nas prowadzą do Boga, którzy nas pouczają, którzy nas otaczają opieką duchową, służą radą i miłością.

Czy jesteśmy w stanie odczytać zapowiedzi, skierowane do nas? Bo w dalszym ciągu czytając słyszymy zapowiedź „Ustanowię zaś nad nimi pasterzy, by je paśli; i nie będą się już więcej lękać ani trwożyć, ani trzeba będzie szukać którejkolwiek.” (Jr 23,4). A więc są słowa skierowane nie tylko do pasterzy, naszych przewodników, ale i do nas, abyśmy byli silni wiarą, abyśmy mieli opiekę duchową, aby nas właściwi ludzie prowadzili drogą ku Bogu, ku wieczności. Dobrze, że w dzisiejszych czytaniach słyszymy o pasterzach, bo zdawać sobie musimy sprawę z tego, że przewodników nam potrzeba i – aby nam przewodzili – powinniśmy ich szanować i słuchać. I Pasterz i Przewodnik, są okreśłani jako nasi mentorzy, Ci którzy nami kierują, podpowiadają, odpowiadają za nas duchowo, In Persona Christi.

Pierwszym Pasterzem i zarazem Kapłanem był Jezus Chrystus. To On nadal nas prowadzi i naucza o wierze, o Bogu Ojcu, o naszej przyszłości, bo „przyszły zwiastował pokój wam, którzyście daleko, i pokój tym, którzy blisko, bo przez Niego jedni i drudzy w jednym Duchu mamy przystęp do Ojca.” (Ef 2,17-18). W XXI wieku, odmiennie jak za czasów Chrystusowych, mamy tę sposobność by bardziej dbać o naszych Pasterzy, jak oni dbają o nas, wsłuchujmy się w słowa podczas Liturgii Słowa, Homilii, listów Pasterskich.

FIRST READING Am 7:12-15

Amaziah, priest of Bethel, said to Amos,
"Off with you, visionary, flee to the land of Judah!
There earn your bread by prophesying,
but never again prophesy in Bethel;
for it is the king's sanctuary and a royal temple."
Amos answered Amaziah, "I was no prophet,
nor have I belonged to a company of prophets;
I was a shepherd and a dresser of sycamores.
The LORD took me from following the flock, and said to me,
Go, prophesy to my people Israel."

SECOND READING Eph 1:3-14

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ,
who has blessed us in Christ
with every spiritual blessing in the heavens,
as he chose us in him, before the foundation of the world,
to be holy and without blemish before him.
In love he destined us for adoption to himself through Jesus Christ,
in accord with the favor of his will,
for the praise of the glory of his grace
that he granted us in the beloved.
In him we have redemption by his blood,
the forgiveness of transgressions,
in accord with the riches of his grace that he lavished upon us.
In all wisdom and insight, he has made known to us
the mystery of his will in accord with his favor
that he set forth in him as a plan for the fullness of times,
to sum up all things in Christ, in heaven and on earth.
In him we were also chosen,
destined in accord with the purpose of the One
who accomplishes all things according to the intention of his will, so
that we might exist for the praise of his glory,
we who first hoped in Christ.
In him you also, who have heard the word of truth,
the gospel of your salvation, and have believed in him,
were sealed with the promised holy Spirit,
which is the first installment of our inheritance
toward redemption as God's possession, to the praise of his glory.

GOSPEL Mk 6:7-13

Jesus summoned the Twelve and began to send them out two by two and gave them authority over unclean spirits.
He instructed them to take nothing for the journey
but a walking stick— no food, no sack, no money in their belts.
They were, however, to wear sandals
but not a second tunic.
He said to them, "Wherever you enter a house, stay there until you
leave. Whatever place does not welcome you or listen to you,
leave there and shake the dust off your feet
in testimony against them."
So they went off and preached repentance.
The Twelve drove out many demons,
and they anointed with oil many who were sick and cured them.

PIERWSZE CZYTANIE Am 7, 12-15

Amazjasz, kapłan w Betel, rzekł do Amosa: «„Widzący”, idź sobie, uciekaj do ziemi Judy! I tam jedz chleb, i tam prorokuj! A w Betel więcej nie prorokuj, bo jest ono królewską świątynią i królewską budowlą».

I odpowiedział Amos Amazjaszowi: «Nie jestem ja prorokiem ani nie jestem synem proroków, gdyż jestem pasterzem i tym, który nacina sykomory. Od trzody bowiem wziął mnie Pan i rzekł do mnie Pan: „Idź, prorokuj do narodu mego, izraelskiego!”»

DRUGIE CZYTANIE Ef 1, 3-14

Niech będzie błogosławiony Bóg i Ojciec Pana naszego, Jezusa Chrystusa; On napełnił nas wszelkim błogosławieństwem duchowym na wyżynach niebieskich – w Chrystusie. W Nim bowiem wybrał nas przed założeniem świata, abyśmy byli święci i nieskalani przed Jego obliczem. Z miłości przeznaczył nas dla siebie jako przybranych synów poprzez Jezusa Chrystusa, według postanowienia swej woli, ku chwale majestatu swej łaski, którą obdarzył nas w Umiłowanym.

W Nim mamy odkupienie przez Jego krew – odpuszczenie występków, według bogactwa Jego łaski. Szczodrze ją na nas wylał w postaci wszelkiej mądrości i zrozumienia, przez to, że nam oznajmił tajemnicę swej woli według swego postanowienia, które przedtem w Nim powziął dla dokonania pełni czasów, aby wszystko na nowo zjednoczyć w Chrystusie jako Głowie: to, co w niebiosach, i to, co na ziemi.

W Nim dostąpiliśmy udziału my również, z góry przeznaczeni zamiarem Tego, który dokonuje wszystkiego zgodnie z zamysłem swej woli, byśmy istnieli ku chwale Jego majestatu – my, którzy już przedtem nadzieję złożyliśmy w Chrystusie. W Nim także i wy, usłyszawszy słowo prawdy, Dobrą Nowinę o waszym zbawieniu, w Nim również – uwierzywszy, zostaliście naznaczeni pieczęcią, Duchem Świętym, który był obiecany. On jest zadatkiem naszego dziedzictwa w oczekiwaniu na odkupienie, które nas uczyni własnością Boga, ku chwale Jego majestatu.

EWANGELIA Mk 6, 7-13

Jezus przywołał do siebie Dwunastu i zaczął rozsyłać ich po dwóch. Dał im też władzę nad duchami nieczystymi i przykazał im, żeby nic z sobą nie brali na drogę prócz łaski: ani chleba, ani torby, ani pieniędzy w trzosi. «Ale idźcie obuci w sandały i nie wdziewajcie dwóch sukien».

I mówił do nich: «Gdy do jakiegoś domu wejdziecie, zostańcie tam, aż stamtąd wyjdziecie. Jeśli w jakimś miejscu was nie przyjmą i nie będą was słuchać, wychodząc stamtąd, strząśnijcie proch z nóg waszych na świadectwo dla nich».

Oni więc wyszli i wzywali do nawracania się. Wyrzucali też wiele złych duchów, a wielu chorych namaszczała olejem i uzdrawiali.

Completed forms should be returned to the Lifelong Faith Formation Office in person, by appointment, by email, or in our drop box located on the east wall of the school building entrance.

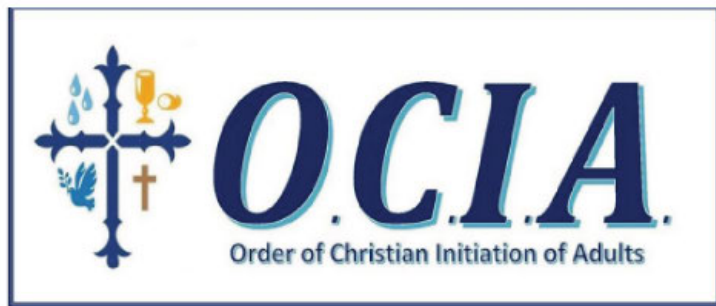

OUR LADY OF MOUNT CARMEL

The origins of this feast reach all the way back to the Old Testament. In the book of Kings, we read the story of the prophet Elijah. Much of his prayer, fasting, and public ministry occurred from Carmel, a mountain in Israel. Christian hermits -- seeking solitude -- made their homes on the mountain during the first millennium. Over time, the hermits assembled into a community and were given a Rule of Life. They named their church after Mary -- Our Lady of Mount Carmel. Political upheaval forced the Carmelite order out of the Holy Land and into Europe, where they established monasteries for both men and women across the continent. Many great saints and doctors of the Church have come from the Carmelite order, including St. Teresa of Avila, St. John of the Cross, St. Therese of Lisieux, and St. Edith Stein.

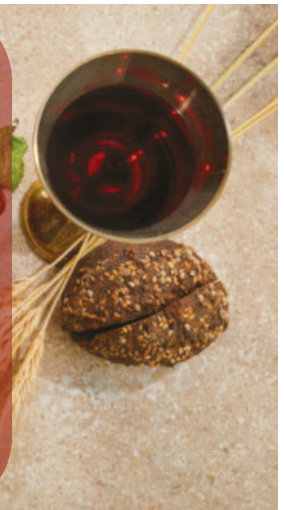

Month of the Most Precious Blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ

July

One drop of his Precious Blood

The Precious Blood of Jesus reminds us of Christ shedding his blood for the salvation of humanity. In the passage of Hebrews 9:14, Paul speaks of Christ's offering of himself through the eternal Spirit, thus cleansing from sin. In the Catechism of the Catholic Church, it tells us that "redemption comes to us above all through the blood of his cross, but this mystery is at work throughout Christ's entire life" (CCC #517).

Relics associated with the Precious Blood are sacred elements. These treasures of the Church include the Shroud of Turin, the Holy Face of Jesus, and pieces of the True Cross, all of which have remains of the Blood of Jesus. These relics not only are historical artifacts but are also seen as pieces of divine grace. They are signs of devotion that draw the faithful closer to the mysteries of Christ's sacrifice.

In the richness of the Church, there are prayers dedicated to the Precious Blood of Je-

sus. The Chaplet of the Precious Blood consists of prayers that invoke the power of Christ's blood for protection, healing, and spiritual strength. Devotees often recite these prayers as acts of reparation for sins and as expressions of gratitude for Christ's redemptive sacrifice.

The saints have left examples of fostering a devotion to the Precious Blood. St. Catherine of Siena dedicated her spiritual life to the Precious Blood. She often meditated on Christ's blood as a symbol of his love and atonement, encouraging the faithful to embrace the transformative power of his sacrifice.

St. Gaspar del Bufalo, the founder of the Missionaries of the Precious Blood, dedicated his life to promoting devotion to the Precious Blood as a means of spiritual renewal and evangelization. These saints' work continues to inspire people to contemplate the profound significance of Christ's redeeming blood.

The Church sets aside liturgical celebrations that commemorate the Precious Blood. These include Corpus Christi, Sacred Heart of Jesus, Exaltation of the Cross, and Good Friday.

These feasts serve as occasions for the faithful to reflect on the role of Christ's blood in the history of salvation and to renew the commitment to living lives of holiness and service.

The Precious Blood of Jesus is essential in the Catholic faith and spirituality. Through these devotional practices, the faithful are invited to contemplate Christ's sacrificial love and to respond with faith, gratitude, and a commitment to living out a life of holiness. □



Did you know?

Chalice is often crafted from precious metals, highlighting the reverence and importance attributed to the Eucharist. Intricate designs, engravings, and embellishments adorn many chalices, reflecting the beauty and solemnity of the Mass.

At Consecration, the wine offered becomes the Blood of Christ through transubstantiation. The chalice holds the Most Precious Blood of Jesus, the true presence of Christ in the Eucharist.

After Communion, the priest, deacon, or acolyte cleanses the chalice with water and carefully consumes it. This cleansing, known as the Purification, ensures the proper handling and respect for any remnants of the Eucharist, and for the sacred vessels used in the celebration of the Mass.

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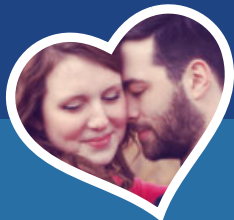
