From the Pastor

Responsibility for Others

Throughout our lives, we are encouraged to be responsible for others, for children, parents, employees or co-workers. This responsibility is also transferred to the spiritual life, to life in the community. This responsibility does not only mean to feed the family, although it is important. But responsibility is also taking care of living in faith, we must take care of our own and those under our care regarding spiritual food, the Eucharist, the food that the Lord has given us.

We see the perfect example of the responsibility that Christ shows when he has been entrusted with the responsibility of feeding the vast crowd of his listeners, those who have followed him by offering them spiritual food and teaching. But Jesus knows perfectly well how and what to do to provide food for those who follow him. For such a huge audience, 5 loaves of bread and 2 fish are enough for him. It is incredible that so many people, whom he first attracts to himself through his charisma and wisdom, can be fed in such a simple - and at the same time miraculous - way, able to satisfy their hunger, not only intellectual, but also the prosaic, human hunger.

What happened on the hill was like a reminder of an event described in the Second Book of Kings, where a similar situation was resolved by God in a way unimaginable to people. The gathered people also expected an expression of responsibility for their fate. The man of God, thanks to the prayers to the Lord, caused that a small amount of food was able to meet people's expectations. He commanded his servant: "Give it to the people to eat. For this is what the Lord says: 'They will eat and have some left over.'" (2 Kings 4:43). It is thanks to the Word of the Lord that it is not only enough for the people, but like in the Gospel, when people are filled, baskets full of fragments of bread remain.

It would seem that both the readings and the Gospel are about eating only. Someone may even say that today we could use more than one such miracle to feed the multitudes of those who are hungry or even starving. But that is not the conclusion. Twice there is food, twice it is blessed, and twice it is left as fragments for others. The breaking of bread has its share in the Eucharist, the fragments left over after the feast are Eucharistic bread for those who forget that eating the Body of Christ during the Holy Mass is our food, even more important than the rest. Through the blessing of the bread, Jesus made enough of it for all. And for us a little reminder – in the past, a prayer was said before each meal, today not everyone does it. In the past, my mother used to mark bread with the sign of the cross, what about today?

Today's Liturgy of the Word calls out to us: Let us not forget two things: first, the blessing of food, second, and in fact above the first, they remind us of what an important food the Eucharist is.

Odpowiedzialność za innych

Przez całe nasze życie, zdopingowani jesteśmy do odpowiedzialności za innych, za dzieci, rodziców, za pracowników lub współpracowników. Odpowiedzialność ta przenosi się również na życie duchowe, na życie we wspólnocie. Odpowiedzialność ta, nie oznacza tylko i wyłącznie, by wyżywić rodzinę, chociaż to jest ważne. Ale odpowiedzialność, to również dbałość o życie w wierze, musimy dbać o naszą i naszych podopiecznych, strawę duchową, o Eucharystię, o tę strawę, którą dał nam Pan.

Widzimy doskonały przykład odpowiedzialności, którą wykazuje Chrystus, kiedy spoczął na nim obowiązek nakarmienia ogromnej rzeszy słuchaczy, tych którzy poszli za Nim, bo zaoferował im strawę duchową, nauczania. Ale Jezus doskonale wie, jak i co ma czynić, by tym, którzy podążają za Nim, zapewnić strawę. Dla tak ogromnej rzeszy słuchaczy wystarcza Mu 5 bochenków chleba i 2 ryby. To niebywałe, że tak wielką rzeszę ludzi, którą wpierw pociąga za sobą, swoją charyzmą i mądrością, potrafi w tak prosty – a jednocześnie cudowny – sposób nakarmić, zasycić ich głód nie tylko intelektualny, ale również ten prozaiczny, ludzki.

To co stało się na wzgórzu, było jakby przypomnieniem zdarzenia opisanego w II Księdze Królewskiej, gdzie sytuacja podobna rozwiązana jest przez Boga w sposób niewyobrażalny dla ludzi. Zgromadzeni ludzie również oczekiwali wyrazu odpowiedzialności za ich los. Mąż Boży, dzięki modlitwom do Pana, spowodował iż małą ilością pożywienia, zdołał zaspokoić oczekiwania ludzi. Rozkazał swojemu słudze: «Podaj ludziom i niech jedzą, bo tak mówi Pan: Nasycą się i pozostawią resztki» (2 Krl 4,43). To dzięki Słowu Pana, nie tylko wystarcza, ale, jak w Ewangelii, po nasyceniu ludzi pozostają kosze pełne ułomków chleba.

Wydawałoby się, że zarówno czytania, jak i Ewangelia traktują wyłącznie o jedzeniu. Ktoś może nawet stwierdzić, że dzisiaj przydałby się niejeden taki cud, by nakarmić rzesze tych, którzy głodują, wręcz przymierają głodem. Ale nie o taki wniosek chodzi. Dwukrotnie jest pożywienie, dwukrotnie jest ono błogosławione i dwukrotnie pozostają ułamki dla innych. Łamanie chleba ma swój udział w Eucharystii, ułamki pozostające po uczcie to chleb Eucharystyczny dla tych, którzy zapominają, że spożywanie podczas Mszy Świętej Ciała Chrystusa to nasze pożywienie, nawet ważniejsze od pozostałego. Poprzez błogosławieństwo chleba Jezus sprawił, iż było go wystarczająco dużo dla wszystkich. A dla nas małe przypomnienie – kiedyś przed każdym posiłkiem odmawiano modlitwę, dzisiaj nie każdy to robi, dawniej matka krojąc chleb znaczyła go znakiem krzyża, a dzisiaj?

Dzisiejsza Liturgia Słowa, woła do nas: Nie zapominajmy o dwu sprawach: po pierwsze o błogosławieństwie pożywienia, po drugie, a w zasadzie ponad pierwsze, przypominają nam, jakim ważnym pożywieniem jest Eucharystia.

The St. Fabian Roof project is moving forward to a start date. As we progress through this project, we will update the parish regularly through our parish bulletin and website.

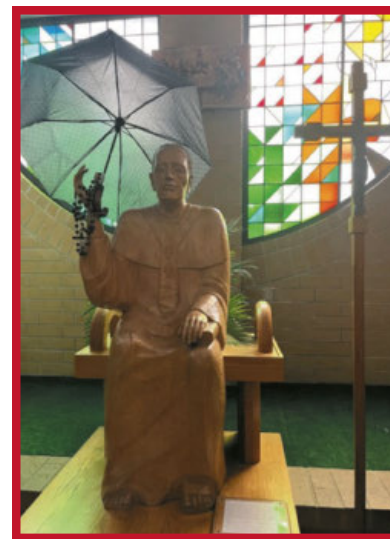

St. Fabian Women's Ministry Barbara Miarka 2024 Scholarship Winners



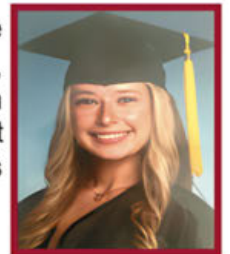

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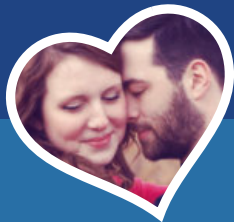
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
